### Incidents

**Fatal Crash Investigation** - On May 23 at 7:48AM, investigators with the Crash Investigation Unit responded to the area of Cardinal Dr. and Swan Way in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a two-vehicle crash. The investigation revealed that the driver of a 2006 Nissan Altima was traveling eastbound on Cardinal Dr. near Swan Way at a high rate of speed when the vehicle struck a 2005 Toyota Camry from behind that was traveling in the same direction. After colliding with the Camry, the Altima left the roadway before striking a guardrail and a chain link fence. The Altima eventually came to a rest on its roof in a nearby retention pond. A male and female occupant inside the Altima were ejected, while a third male occupant crawled out of the vehicle and initially fled the scene before being located by officers near Eastlawn Ave. The female occupant in the Altima died at the scene as a result of her injuries sustained in the crash. One of the male occupants in the Altima was flown to an area hospital with life-threatening injuries while the third male occupant was transported to an area hospital with minor injuries. At this time, investigators are continuing their investigation into the crash to determine who was driving the Altima at the time of the collision. The driver, and sole occupant of the Camry, was not injured. The investigation continues.

The second occupant of the 2006 Nissan Altima was identified as a **26-year-old man** of Woodbridge

The third occupant of the 2006 Nissan Altima was identified as a **29-year-old man** of Woodbridge

The driver of the 2005 Toyota Camry was identified as a **32-year-old man** of Woodbridge

**Shooting Investigation** – On May 21 at 9:25PM, officers responded to the Lake Montclair Center located at 5061 Waterway Dr. in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a shooting. While responding, officers received information that an involved vehicle was in the area of Waterway Dr. and Golf Club Dr. When officers located the vehicle, they made contact with the occupants, identified as a 19-year-old man and 20-year-old man, both of whom were suffering from non-life threatening gunshot wounds. Officers rendered aid to the men until rescue personnel arrived and transported them to area hospitals for further treatment. The investigation revealed that while parked in the shopping center parking lot, the two men were struck by gunfire. The men fled the area in their vehicle before stopping a short distance away and notifying the police. A police K-9 and Fairfax County police helicopter searched the area for any other parties involved. Detectives with the Violent Crimes Bureau are actively investigating the incident to determine what led up to the shooting. Detectives continue to seek assistance from any witness to the incident. The investigation continues.

**Indecent Exposure** – On May 21 at 6:12PM, officers responded to the area of Talon Dr. and Dumfries Rd. in Dumfries (22025) to investigate an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed that while in the above area, the victims, identified as a 32-year-old woman and 61-year-old woman, observed the driver of a white Mercedes, exit his vehicle, and approach their vehicle. During the encounter, the suspect exposed himself to the victims before making inappropriate gestures. After a short time, the suspect returned to his vehicle and fled the area. At no time did the suspect make verbal or physical contact with the victims. The only suspect description is a Hispanic male.

## Arrests

**Strangulation | Domestic Assault and Battery** – On May 22 at 11:59AM, officers responded to investigate a domestic that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 1500 block Hylton Ave. in Woodbridge (22191) the prior evening. The victim, a 38-year-old woman, reported to police that she and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim. The parties temporarily separated while remaining inside the home. A short time later, a second verbal altercation ensued before the accused grabbed the victim's throat. The parties eventually separated, and the victim left the residence the following day and contacted the police. The victim reported minor injuries. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, and on May 23, the accused, Henry Miguel **TIRADO**, was located and taken into custody.

**Abduction | Assault and Battery** – On May 21 at 7:57AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 19100 block of Windsor Rd. in Triangle (22172) to investigate an assault. The victim, a 21-year-old man, reported to police that while inside the home, he and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused wrapped a rope around the victim before striking him several times. The parties eventually separated, and the police were contacted. While investigating, officers determined that the victim's iPad was damaged during the altercation. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Alcibiades **ARANGO**, was arrested.

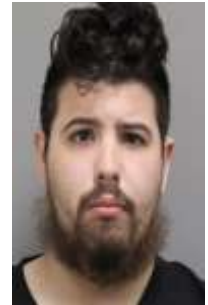

**Abduction | Domestic Related** – On May 20 at 9:30PM, officers responded to the area of Meridian Dr. and Melbourne Ave. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a domestic. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 28-year-old woman and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, stopped in the above area where a verbal altercation escalated inside of the vehicle. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim. When the victim attempted to exit the vehicle, the accused grabbed her and prevented her from leaving. While inside the vehicle, the victim began to yell, and caught the attention of an individual nearby who intervened. The parties were separated, and the police were notified. The victim reported minor injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Roberto Luis **ESTRELLA**, was arrested.

**Felony Child Neglect** – On May 21 at 11:16AM, officers responded to the Sam's Club located at 14050 Worth Ave. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a child neglect call. Upon arrival, officers located a vehicle that was not running and occupied by an unsupervised 11-month-old boy. Officers forced entry into the locked vehicle and removed the child who was not injured. The investigation revealed that the mother, identified as the accused, left the child and a 3-year-old boy, inside the vehicle while she went into the store. At one point, the 3-year-old exited the vehicle and made contact with another patron in the parking lot who notified the police. Both children were transported to an area hospital and later released to a family member. The accused, identified as Esmeralda **CHAVIRA**, was arrested.

**Malicious Wounding | Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]** - On May 21 at 5:30PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 12800 block of Bison Ct. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a domestic. Upon arrival, officers observed the victim, a 31-year-old woman, with visible injuries, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, who were outside of the home. Officers observed the accused running around parked vehicles, not responding to officers, or following their commands. When officers attempted to detain the accused, he actively resisted before being taken into custody without further incident. During the altercation, the accused kicked an officer. The victim reported to police that she woke to the accused grabbing her arm and acting out of the ordinary. A verbal altercation ensued and, at one point, the accused repeatedly bit the victim. During the altercation, the victim was yelling loud enough for a neighbor to intervene, and eventually both parties exited the home prior to police arriving at the residence. The victim reported minor injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Antijuaine Darrell **SYRKES**, was arrested.
