Incidents

Armed Robbery – On May 24 at 7:45AM, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred at the Potomac Inn located at 13964 Jefferson Davis Hwy. in Woodbridge (22191) on the evening of May 23. The victim, a 39-year-old man, reported to police that while in the parking lot of the above area, he met with an acquaintance to purchase marijuana. Before the sale was complete, a verbal altercation between the victim and the acquaintance ensued. At one point, two unknown men exited a nearby vehicle and approached the victim where one of the men then brandished a firearm. The suspect then demanded the victim's property and temporarily grabbed onto the victim before the victim was able to break free and run from the area. The victim initially contacted the police shortly after the incident; however, he did not want to report the incident until later in the morning. No injuries were reported. The only suspect information available at this time is three black males. The investigation continues.

Residential Burglary – On May 26 at 2:42AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 6100 block of Spindle Tree Ct. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a burglary. The homeowner reported to police that he woke from hearing a loud noise in the basement area of his home. When he went to investigate the noise, he heard unknown voices in the basement and went back upstairs where he contacted the police. The investigation revealed that entry was made into the home through the rear basement door which was found damaged. No property was reported missing.

Arrests

Malicious Wounding | Domestic Related – On May 25 at 11:30AM, officers responded to the Summertree Condos located in the 7500 block of Margate Ct. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a domestic. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 30-year-old man, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim before retrieving a knife and attempting to stab the victim. A struggle ensued over the knife which resulted in the victim being cut. Shortly after being cut, the victim ran from the apartment, and was later located by officers nearby. The victim reported serious injuries. While investigating, the accused reported complications from an unrelated issue and was transported to an area hospital. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Larainda Virginia Kelly **DANIEL**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On May 24 at 11:38PM, officers on patrol in the area of the 7-Eleven located at 13990 Jefferson Davis Hwy. in Woodbridge (22191) located a man, later identified as the accused, who had active warrants for his arrest. Upon making contact with the accused and informing him he was under arrest, the accused fled on foot. After a foot pursuit, a brief struggle ensued before the accused was taken into custody without further incident. During the encounter, the accused struck two officers. The accused was transported to an area hospital for minor injuries sustained during the altercation and released. During a search incident to arrest, officers located suspected illegal narcotics in the accused possession. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Darryck Dawayne Edward **SMITH**, was arrested.
