### Incidents

**Brandishing | Road Rage Related** – On May 29 at 3:39PM, officers responded to the intersection of Jefferson Davis Hwy. and Squire Ln. in Triangle (22172) to investigate a brandishing. The investigation revealed that the victims, a 29-year-old man and a 25-year-old woman were traveling south on Jefferson Davis Hwy. when they observed a black Nissan Sentra pass them very closely before continuing to weave between lanes of travel. As both vehicles approached the above intersection, they stopped next to each other at the traffic signal. The driver of the Sentra then engaged the victims in a verbal altercation before getting out of his vehicle and brandishing a machete. When the victim stated she was going to contact the police, the suspect got back into his vehicle and fled the area. The victims initially followed the suspect however, when the suspect parked his vehicle and brandished the machete a second time and the victims left the area. At no time did the suspect make physical contact with either of the victims.

***Suspect Description:***

A white male, between 4-50 years of age, 6'2", 200lbs., with short hair, and who appeared unshaven  
Last seen wearing a black wind breaker style jacket

**Residential Burglary** – On May 28 at 4:11PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 5000 block of Catharpin Rd. in Gainesville (20155) to investigate a burglary. The homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred sometime between 9:45AM and 1:00PM. The investigation revealed that entry was made into the home through the rear deck door on the second level which was found unsecured. No property was reported missing, however, several items inside the home were tampered with.

## Arrests

**Malicious Wounding** – On May 29 at 11:37PM, officers responded to the Summerland Heights Apartments located in the 1800 block of Gableridge Turn in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a fight with weapons. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 40-year-old man, went to his neighbors apartment upon hearing the fire alarm. As the victim was assisting the residents of the apartment, a verbal altercation ensued between the residents. When the victim intervened, one of the residents, identified as the accused, struck and bit the victim, before the victim was able to separate himself. Officers located the accused inside his apartment and took him into custody without incident. The victim reported significant injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Harvin **ARGUETA HERRERA**, was arrested.

**Abduction | Burglary** – On May 26 at 10:34AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 9200 block of Brentsville Rd. in Manassas (20112) to investigate a domestic. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 21-year-old woman, and a 22-year-old male acquaintance were inside the home when they observed a second acquaintance, identified as the accused, drive into the driveway. The victim locked the doors however, the accused entered her home without permission. Once inside, the accused damaged an interior door and a wall while trying to locate the male victim. Once the accused located the male victim, he prevented him from leaving the room and a physical altercation ensued. Eventually the male victim was able to separate himself from the accused and left the residence. A family member intervened and the accused left prior to police arrival. The male victim reported minor injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Edwin Noe **CHAVARRIA**, was located in the Woodbridge area and arrested.

### Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] | Residential Burglaries –

On May 29 at 3:09PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 1900 block of Winslow Ct. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a burglary. The homeowner reported to police that he was inside his residence when he observed an acquaintance, identified as the accused, take rocks, and begin to force entry into his home through the sliding glass door. The homeowner retreated into another room and contacted the police. The investigation revealed that the accused made entry into the home and took an undisclosed amount of money and property before fleeing. There was no contact between the homeowner and the accused. While canvassing, officers observed the accused nearby and when they attempted to detain him, the accused fled on foot. The accused refused to follow officer's commands and after a short foot pursuit, the officers made contact with the accused where the accused continued to actively resist being taken into custody. During the altercation, the accused pushed the officer and attempted to take his Electronic Restraint Device before the accused struck and bit the officer. Additional officers arrived at the location and the accused was taken into custody without further incident. During the investigation, officers were approached by a resident of a home located in the 1700 block of Powder Horn Ter. who stated that the accused had forced entry into his home. The investigation into the second incident revealed that the accused shattered the rear sliding glass door of the residence before pouring gasoline on the floor. The second incident is being investigated by investigators with the Department of Fire & Rescue, Fire Marshal's Office. Minor injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Carlo Peter **GENOVA**, was arrested.

**Stalking** – On May 29 at 10:30PM, officers responded to the Point at Manassas Apartments located in the 11200 block of Chatterly Lp. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a stalking. The victim, a 23-year-old woman, reported to police that she was being harassed and stalked by her car insurance agent, later identified as the accused. The investigation revealed that between May 10 and May 29, the accused used his position as the victim's new car insurance agent, to solicit her for a romantic relationship. When the victim declined, the accused continued to contact the victim, sent her inappropriate photos, and left items on the victim's vehicle for her. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Eduardo **ESCOBAR CASTEDO**, was located in Manassas and arrested.

**Residential Burglary** – On May 29 at 10:00AM, officers responded to the Stone Pointe Apartments located in the 14900 block of Potomac Heights Pl. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a burglary. The victim, a 27-year-old woman, reported to police that an acquaintance, identified as the accused, kicked in the locked front door when she would not open the door for him. Upon making entry into the home, the accused pushed the victim into her bedroom where he got on top of her and prevented her from leaving. The victim was able to separate herself from the accused and ran into another room before the accused fled on foot. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Jerrell Travis **MITCHELL**. Later that evening **MITCHELL** turned himself in without incident.
