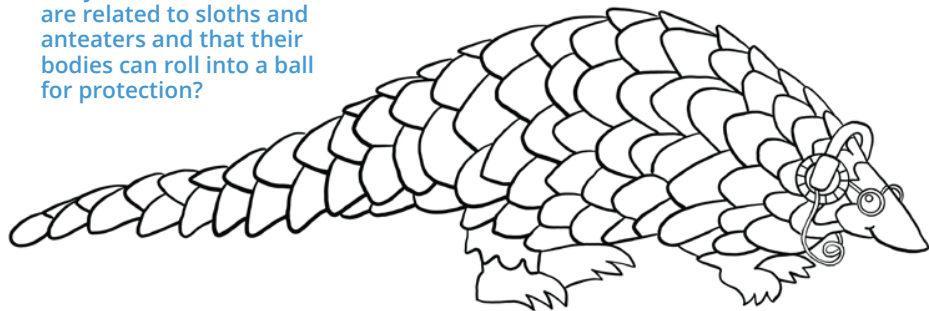

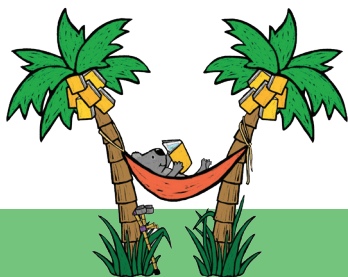

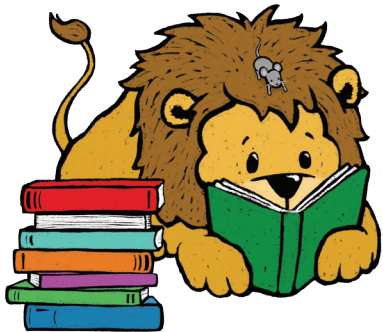
Why do animals have tails? Why don't humans? This year's Summer Reading theme, Tails and Tales, is all about learning, reading, and having fun!
