Reckless Driving *ARREST – On June 1, investigators with the Crash Investigation Unit concluded the investigation into the crash that was reported to have occurred in the area of Interstate Dr. and Briarwood Dr. in Dumfries (22026) on May 31. The investigation revealed that the operator of the dirt bike left the crash location to obtain medical treatment and then reported the incident to police. Following the investigation, the operator of the dirt bike, identified as Tyce Jordan **DUNCAN**, was charged.

Felony Hit & Run [Previously Released] – On May 31 at 9:11PM, officers responded to the area of Interstate Dr and Briarwood Dr in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a hit and run crash. The investigation revealed that the operator of a 2017 Kawasaki KX100 dirt bike was traveling eastbound on Interstate Dr when the dirt bike crossed in front of a 2021 Harley Davidson Road Glide Ultra motorcycle traveling in the opposite direction. Both operators separated from their bikes. The operator of the dirt bike fled the scene following the collision. The operator of the Harley Davidson motorcycle was flown to area hospital with serious, non-life threatening injuries. No description is available for the suspect at this time.

Attempted Residential Burglary – On June 2 at 7:00PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 16000 block of Hayes Ln. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted burglary. The homeowner reported to police that at approximately 10:00AM, the home's rear video surveillance was activated showing an unknown man, later identified as the accused, enter the fenced backyard before attempting to gain entry into the home through a secured rear door. When the accused was unable to make entry into the residence, he left the area on foot. No entry was made into the home and no property was reported missing. While investigating, officers were able to identify the accused as Joshua James **LEWIS**. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for **LEWIS** and attempts to locate him have been unsuccessful.

Attempted Residential Burglary – On June 2 at 7:51AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 3500 block of Shandor Rd. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate an attempted burglary. The homeowner reported to police that at approximately 2:22AM, video surveillance footage showed multiple unknown individuals attempting to enter the home through the rear sliding glass door. The suspects fled the area when an alarm began to sound. No entry was made into the home and no property was reported missing.

Arrests

Unlawful Wounding – On June 1 at 10:09PM, detectives with the Special Victims Unit began an investigation into an assault that was reported to have occurred in the area of Gordon Blvd. and Old Bridge Rd. in Woodbridge (22192) on May 30. The investigation revealed that while traveling together in the above area, the victim, a 35-year-old woman, and a 44-year-old male acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim several times in the face. Eventually the parties separated, and the victim sought treatment for serious injuries at an area hospital. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Andre Rashad **HARRIS**, was arrested.
