## SOVEREIGN CITIZENS, ANTI-GOVERNMENT INDIVIDUALS, & FIRST-AMENDMENT AUDITORS

This dynamic and immersive training focuses on sovereign citizens and their increasingly problematic contact with all forms of government, although the specific focus is on interactions with law enforcement and criminal justice personnel. Basic awareness of this growing threat, and how it affects the daily duties and responsibilities of law enforcement, and other government entities, will be discussed at length. Additionally, a portion of the course covers First-Amendment Auditors and their increasing contact with law enforcement and government officials across the United States.

## DOMESTIC TERRORISM & HATE GROUPS

This timely and relevant training provides an introductory overview of numerous domestic terror groups and criminally subversive subcultures that are encountered by law enforcement daily. The course provides a definition of violent extremism and focuses on individuals and groups who attempt to advance social or political beliefs through force or violence. Attendees will review the First Amendment and Constitutional protections afforded to all groups discussed and discern between criminal activity and protected speech and actions.
