<u>Defining Aging & Disability – An Aid for Discussions</u>
Older Americans Act – Age 60 and Older - "Vintage Virginians"

"Older" Age Range – Ages 60 to 74
"Elderly" or "Aged" (preferred wording) Age Range – Ages 75 to 84
"Oldest Old" Age Range – Ages 85 to 99
"Centenarians" Age Range – Ages 100+

"Frail Elderly" – Age 65 and over with significant physical & cognitive health problems or agerelated infirmities

"Disability" - the term means, with respect to an individual, (a) a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more Major Life Activities of such individual; (b) a record of such impairment; or (c) being regarded as having such an impairment. The term shall not apply to impairments that are transitory (actual or expected duration of 3 months or less) and minor. [Sec. 12102(1) and (3), ADA of 1990 as Amended]

"Major Life Activities" - include, but are not limited to, caring for oneself, performing manual tasks, seeing, hearing, eating, sleeping, walking, standing, lifting, bending, speaking, breathing, learning, reading, concentrating, thinking, communicating, and working. Major Life Activities also include operation of a major bodily function [Sec. 12102(2)(A)(B)]

- "Baby Boomer" those born between 1946 1964
- "Senior" no age range; depends on context of use
- "Senior Citizen" first used in 1938 to denote civic position of older adults; traditional term for those age 65 and older.
