Incidents

Justified-Homicide Investigation – On July 22 at 12:25AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 4100 block of Hoffman Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a shooting. The victim, identified as a 44-year-old woman, reported to police that she was exiting her residence when she observed an unknown, masked individual armed with a handgun approaching her from the side of the home. The victim, who was also armed at the time, shot the individual as they approached the front door of her residence. Officers arrived at the home and located a man near the doorway of the residence suffering from gunshot wounds. Officers also located a loaded handgun in the man's possession. Officers performed CPR on the man until rescue personnel arrived. The man was transported to an area hospital where he later died as a result of his injuries. The victim was not injured. At this time, detectives from the Homicide Unit are actively investigating the incident to determine why the man was at the residence and are seeking to speak to anyone who may have been present around the time of the incident. After consultation with the Commonwealth Attorney's Office, the shooting was ruled to be justified based on self-defense and therefore no charges will be placed against the victim. **At this time, this incident does not appear to be random.** More information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

The deceased was identified as Azhar Laurent **SMART**, 20, of Triangle

Reckless Handling of a Firearm – On July 21 at 9:40AM, officers responded to the area of River Heritage Blvd. near Thoroughgood Dr. in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a shots fired call. Residents reported to police that sometime around 11:50PM on July 20, loud noises were heard in the area. While investigating, officers located shell casings in the roadway. The investigation revealed that the shots were fired before a dark-colored sedan was seen fleeing the area. No injuries or property damage were reported. No further suspect description is available.

Commercial Burglary – On July 22 at 2:41AM, officers responded to Unique Soles located at 2894 Garber Way in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an alarm activation. Upon arrival, officers located an unsecured rear door and observed an unknown individual inside the business. The individual fled through the broken glass door at the front of the business before officers could make contact. The business owner reported to police that he was alerted to an alarm activation and viewed video surveillance footage that revealed two unknown individuals inside the business loading property into a dark-colored sedan that was parked in the rear of the business. The sedan fled the area prior to police arriving at the location. A police K-9 and Fairfax County police helicopter searched the area for the suspects who were not located. Shoes were reported missing. The only suspect description at this time is two individuals wearing all dark-colored clothing.

Residential Burglary – On July 20 at 1:20PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 14100 block of Fullerton Rd. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a burglary. The homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred sometime between 12:00AM on July 18 and 12:00AM on July 20. The investigation revealed that entry was made into the home through the side of the home under construction. A television and jewelry were reported missing.

Malicious Wounding | Domestic Related – On July 21 at 7:07PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 11800 block of Belmont Farm Ln. in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a domestic with weapons. The investigation revealed that the accused and a family member were involved in an altercation when the victim, a 41-year-old male family member, intervened. The accused then retrieved a knife and swung it several times, striking the victim. After a brief struggle the parties separated, and the accused went outside where he encountered officers as they arrived at the location. The victim and the accused reported minor injuries that were sustained during the encounter. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Mohammad Firoz **MAHMUD**, was arrested.

Commercial Burglary – On July 20 at 9:53PM, officers responded to the American Auto Salvage located at 14210 Jefferson Davis Hwy. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a burglary. The business owner reported to police that the burglary occurred on July 19 at approximately 2:14AM. Video surveillance footage revealed that two unknown men entered the business through the side door which was found damaged. While inside, they took several keys to vehicles in the lot before leaving in a Chevrolet Silverado. On the morning of July 20, an employee of the salvage business observed the Silverado at a nearby business and when he confronted them, the suspects drove to the area of Potomac Mills Rd. where they fled on foot. The employee contacted the police and while canvassing the area, officers located the two occupants of the vehicle, identified as Justin Amond **DUNMORE** and Harrison R. **BILLINGSLY**, who were then taken into custody. While investigating, officers determined that **DUNMORE** was also involved in the above-mentioned burglary. During a search incident to arrest, **BILLINGSLY**, was found in possession of a controlled substance. The case remains active as officers attempt to identify the second suspect involved in the burglary.
