If you are not registered for a FREE COVID-19 vaccination, please visit [VACCINATE.VIRGINIA.GOV](https://vaccinate.virginia.gov). Sign up on the waitlist to get the free vaccine. Register even if you are not sure you want the vaccine. Registering puts you closer to getting vaccinated if you chose to get vaccinated. All three COVID-19 vaccines; Moderna, Pfizer, and Johnson & Johnson are highly effective at preventing COVID-19 related hospitalizations and death.

This will be the last week Prince William Health District will use the George Mason University clinic at Beacon Hall. We would like to thank the University and all the staff that helped to make this clinic a success in allowing us to vaccinate all the residents that came through the clinic. The Beacon Hall clinic was able to distribute over 7,000 vaccines.

This past week: Two mass vaccination clinics distributed 2,000 doses of the one-shot Johnson & Johnson vaccine at both Gander Mountain and the Mason and Partners clinic. The PWHD partnered with the homeless shelters and services to vaccinate 158 homeless residents who opted to be vaccinated.

Monday, March 15, and Thursday, March 18, the clinic will administer the Moderna vaccine first doses from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Thursday's clinic will be administering 1,200 Moderna second doses from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Manassas Mall, [8300 Sudley Rd, Manassas, VA 20109](https://www.google.com/maps/place/8300+Sudley+Rd,+Manassas,+VA+20109) will operate from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Friday, March 19, administering the Moderna vaccine of 750-second doses, and Saturday, March 20 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. administering the Moderna vaccine 750 first doses.

Beacon Hall, [10945 George Mason Circle, Manassas, VA 20110](https://www.google.com/maps/place/10945+George+Mason+Circle,+Manassas,+VA+20110), on the Manassas Campus of George Mason University. The clinic will operate from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday, March 16, and Friday, March 19. On Tuesday, the clinic will administer 550 first doses of the Moderna vaccine. On Friday, the clinic will administer 750-second doses of Moderna.
