Community Vaccination Center Started This Week March 23, 2021, at the Old Gander Mountain Store Location

A **Community Vaccination Center**, or **CVC**, is another clinic to vaccinate people in the Prince William Health District. The location is the former **Gander Mountain** store, located at <u>14011 Worth Avenue</u>, <u>Woodbridge</u>, <u>VA 22192</u>. They are administering the Pfizer Vaccine.

Below are some helpful hints for members of the public scheduled to visit one of these sites:

- Arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to your appointment time. You will not be allowed in early to receive your vaccine.
- No walk-ins will be accepted at this time. Please pre-register to be contacted for an appointment.
- Bring a copy of your invitation (email, text, QR code) and proof of your name when you arrive at the site and have it ready as you approach the main building entrance.

Those vaccinated at the CVC will come from the State's pre-registration list. If you are not pre-registered, now is the time to get registered. To register, go to: VACCINATE.VIRGINIA.GOV or **call 1-877-VAX-IN-VA**.

Please update your registration record if your status has changed. If you have already been vaccinated, it is important to update your Vaccinate Virginia pre-









registration record with your correct first name, last name and date of birth. This will ensure that you are automatically removed from the waitlist once you are vaccinated. Do not hesitate to sign up today even if you are uncertain if you want the vaccine. It will not obligate you to get vaccinated when it is your turn.

PWHD Vaccination Clinic Manassas Mall: Monday-Saturday

Manassas Mall, <u>8300 Sudley Rd</u>, <u>Manassas</u>, <u>VA 20109</u> will operate from 9 am to 4 pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, on Thursday from 1 pm to 7 pm, and on Saturday March 27 from 9 am to 4 pm. The clinic is currently administering Moderna vaccine.

Things you need to know if you have a scheduled appointment at Manassas Mall:

- Driver's license or Driver Privilege card needs to have a PWC, City of Manassas or City of Manassas Park address.
- Change of address should be presented or a utility bill (to prove residency).
- Worker badge with Prince William Health District address.
- If you live outside the PWHD but work in the PWHD jurisdiction, you will need to bring ID to verify your employment and you must meet one of the categories that is currently eligible for vaccination.
- The Manassas Mall clinic will not accept non-PWHD residents who did not receive an official appointment scheduling link for the person intended.
- The PWHD will actively check for eligibility.

PWHD appointment notifications may include the following information:

 Appointments booked from the PWHD Call Center will begin as a notification phone call / SMS text / email polling for availability using the Everbridge system. <u>The initial contact is NOT a confirmed appointment.</u> The recipient must confirm their availability (or report they have already been vaccinated).









- Emails come from "Prince William Health District"
 (noreply@everbridge.net). To confirm, the recipient must click the link in the message that corresponds to the response.
- Phone calls come from 703-872-7759. The caller ID will show "PWHD CALL CNTR" on compatible devices. The recipient must listen to the entire message, press the key that corresponds to their choice, and listen for the "Thank you. Your response has been recorded," message.
- SMS texts come from 88911 or 86391. Recipients must click the https://evb.gg/######## link to select a choice or respond back with the number that corresponds to their choice. It is best to click the link and respond in a web browser. If responding by text, reply with ONLY the number – no other text.

From this point forward, all initial messages from the PWHD Call Center will clearly state "You will receive a link to schedule a specific appointment time within 36 hours before the date you selected." If you share the link with anyone or use this link from a friend or family member that shared it with you, your appointment will be cancelled.
