#### **PWHD Vaccination Progress**

- Running Total: As of March 8, 2021, 94,742 people have been vaccinated in the PWHD by the local health district, hospitals, medical care providers, federal Long Term Care Facilities (LTCF) program and other community health care providers.
- Last week: Residents in the PWHD received 7,042 first doses and 6,684-second doses.

### **NEW Publicly Accessible Dashboard**

The Emergency Operations Center has worked with the PWHD to create a <a href="PWHD COVID-19 Vaccine Dashboard">PWHD COVID-19 Vaccine Dashboard</a>. This data is derived from publicly accessible data feeds that VDH has made available. The dashboard will update in real-time; however, the daily update cadence for the data feeds is generally by noon daily.

Please note that this is data from the State. It includes data from all providers (hospitals, PWHD, medical practices, other community health providers, pharmacies).

## **New PrepMod Scheduling System**

Appointments are currently made through the PrepMod system. When it is your turn to schedule an appointment, you will receive an email, phone call, or text message from the PWHD Call Center. First, a representative will ask if you are









available for a particular day and willing to accept the vaccine administered at that clinic site. Second, you will receive a follow-up notification with a link to the scheduling process. After selecting an appointment slot, you have 15 minutes to complete the scheduling process. Please do not share this link with your family members or friends, as doing so will forfeit your allocated appointment. # PWHD COVID Vaccination Clinics No walk-ins, by appointment only.

Gander Mountain, <u>14011 Worth Avenue</u>, <u>Woodbridge</u>, <u>VA 22192</u>. Wednesday, March 10, and Friday, March 12, the clinic will administer Moderna second doses only from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Manassas Mall, <u>8300 Sudley Rd, Manassas, VA 20109</u> and Beacon Hall <u>10945 George Mason Circle, Manassas, VA 20110</u> will each operate from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 9 and Thursday, March 11. The clinics will each administer Moderna first doses only using the PrepMod vaccine registration system.
