Governor Says Virginia's Moving Forward

The state is now in Phase 2 of the vaccine rollout, which means, if you are 16 and older, you are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine.

There is a high demand in Northern Virginia to be vaccinated. It may take a few weeks to get appointments for everyone to get a vaccine.

- To sign up or to schedule a FREE COVID-19 vaccine, visit vaccinate.virginia.gov.
- You can sign up or schedule an appointment by calling 1-877-VAX-IN-VA (1-877-829-4682).
- Virginia's call center is open seven days a week (8am–8pm).

The Prince William Health District (PWHD) is inviting **people who are preregistered** for vaccine appointments. You can preregister at **vaccinate.virginia.gov**.

Please know, if you are in <u>Phase 1a, 1b, or 1c</u> and you cannot find an appointment through <u>VaccineFinder.org</u>, you can preregister for a **priority appointment**, and the health district will contact you as soon as possible to schedule your appointment.









COVID-19 Variant Information

COVID Testing Update

COVID testing is another important tool to help end the pandemic. This testing allows communities and the health district to understand what variants may be present in Virginia.

Testing allows us to help stop the virus from spreading by having people who test positive isolate and work with contact tracers to alert others who may have been exposed.
