WHERE CAN YOU GET A COVID-19 VACCINE FOR YOUR 12-TO 15-YEAR-OLD?

(Manassas, VA) – The **Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine** is currently the only COVID-19 vaccine authorized for use in children 12- to 15- year olds. Earlier this week, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) expanded the use of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to this age group. **To learn more about the COVID-19 vaccine for Teens and Preteens,** click here: <u>https://bit.ly/2SHRTx0</u>.

Across the street from the Potomac Mills Mall is the **Community Vaccination Center (CVC).** This center is vaccinating the 12-15 age group using the **Pfizer vaccine.** The hours for the CVC are 8:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. It is located at the former Gander Mountain building at <u>14011 Worth Avenue, Woodbridge, VA, 22192.</u>

CVC Adolescent Appointments

- Appointments are highly recommended. It ensures a scheduled time for the child's vaccine and makes the vaccination visit more convenient.
- A parent or guardian MUST accompany children ages 12 to 15 to the CVC for the appointment.
- If the child is accompanied by a guardian, the guardian will need to provide proof of guardianship.
- A parent or guardian will verbally verify the child's age.
- To schedule an appointment for the CVC, go to <u>vase.vdh.virginia.gov</u>, for Distance Range, you must enter "25-miles" and search for Vaccine Type "Pfizer."

More Options: Pfizer Vaccine Appointments

- You can reach out to your child's pediatrician or primary care provider and see if they are providing the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine.
- You can go to <u>vaccinate.virginia.gov</u> and search for locations offering the Pfizer vaccine.
- You can call Virginia's call center at 877-VAX-IN-VA (877-829-4682) to ask for help in finding an appointment for your child.
 - Currently, the call center hours are 8 a.m. until 8 p.m., seven days a week. The hours will change beginning Monday, May 17, to 8 a.m. until 6 p.m., Mondays through Saturdays.
