HERE IS A CHANCE FOR 16 AND 17-YEAR-OLDS TO GET VACCINATED

Pfizer is the only COVID-19 Vaccine Approved for Anyone 16 and Older

On Tuesday, May 4, the MAP Clinic will use the **Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine**. The clinic starts at 8 a.m., and the last appointment is expected to be at 2:30 p.m. The clinic is at the Manassas Park Community Center, <u>99 Adam Street</u>. *Clinic walk-up appointments are based on availability. *

What if you cannot make Tuesday's clinic?

Getting a vaccine appointment has gotten a whole lot easier with opportunities to select the vaccine you want; Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson and Johnson.

- Select 25-miles for the Distance Range.
- 3. Select your vaccine type.

The call center is open seven days a week (8 a.m.–8 p.m.).

COVID Testing Continues to be Critical

COVID testing and vaccinations are critical in ending this pandemic. Testing can save a life. Testing can help to determine who has been exposed to a COVID case and supports public health in limiting the spread. This is extremely important because of the continued increase in COVID-19 variants. Some of these variants are more easily spread.
