VIRTUAL REMEMBRANCE CEREMONY FOR THE +2,000 COVID-19 DEATHS IN NORTHERN VIRGINIA

**Plus: Heading on vacation, does your checklist include
getting your kids vaccinated?**

(Manassas, VA) – Tonight's virtual remembrance ceremony will honor and remember the more than 2,350 friends, neighbors and loved ones in Northern Virginia who have died since last March due to COVID-19.

Prince William County – 499 deaths

Manassas City – 47 deaths

Manassas Park – 11 deaths

Hospitalizations and Adolescents with COVID

A [report](#) last week by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention shows an increase in hospitalizations among adolescents (12-17 year olds) with severe cases of COVID-19.

- Children 12 to 17 are eligible to be vaccinated.
- Pfizer is the only COVID-19 vaccine authorized for use in children 12 to 17.

The **Community Vaccination Center (CVC)** offers the **Pfizer vaccine**.
