



## DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

### Incidents

**Attempted Bank Robbery** – On September 15 at 4:56PM, officers responded to the BB&T (Truist Bank) located at 12435 Dillingham Sq in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an attempted robbery. The investigation revealed that an unknown man entered the bank and approached the teller counter. The man passed a note to the teller demanding money and implied he was armed. The suspect fled the bank, possibly on foot, without taking any money. No injuries were reported, and no weapon was seen. A police K-9 and helicopter assistance from Fairfax County police searched the area for the suspect who was not located. The same suspect was possibly in the bank earlier in the day. Nothing of note occurred during that encounter. The investigation continues.

***Suspect Description:***

Black male, unknown age, with a medium to heavy build

Last seen wearing a blue & gray flannel shirt, light-colored jeans, gray shoes, and a red hat
