### Incidents

**Fatal Crash Investigation** – On October 12 at 10:33PM, officers responded to the 12500 block of Purcell Rd in Manassas (20112) to investigate a single vehicle crash. The investigation revealed that a juvenile driver of a 2004 Acura LX was traveling northwest on Purcell Rd at a high rate of speed. The driver eventually lost control of the vehicle which then left the roadway and struck a ditch causing the vehicle to roll several times. The driver was not wearing a seatbelt at the time of the crash and was ejected from the vehicle. A passenger inside the vehicle was wearing a seatbelt and sustained minor injuries. The passenger of the vehicle and an acquaintance driving in a second vehicle behind the Acura drove the injured driver to an area hospital where he later died as a result of his injuries. Due to a change in Virginia law, the identity of the juvenile driver is not being disclosed. The investigation continues.

**Identified:**

The deceased driver of the 2004 Acura LX was identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile** of Woodbridge

The passenger in the 2004 Acura LX was identified as a **14-year-old male juvenile** of Woodbridge

**Shooting Investigation** – On October 12 at 8:29PM, officers responded to the 1400 block of Cottonwood Ct. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed that two groups of individuals were near the above area when gunfire was exchanged. Some of the individuals from one of the groups ran to a nearby residence and contacted the police, while other individuals fled in a light-colored vehicle prior to police arriving in the area. No injuries were reported. While canvassing officers located two unoccupied vehicles that sustained damage consistent with being struck by projectiles. **This incident does not appear random.** The investigation continues.

**Shooting Investigation** – On October 9 at 11:15PM, officers responded to investigate a shooting reported to have occurred in the 7000 block of Lakota Dr. in Woodbridge (22192) earlier that evening. The victim, a 25-year-old man, reported to police that he arranged to sell marijuana to an unknown person via a social media app. The investigation revealed the victim and a 19-year-old female acquaintance were in the area to conduct the transaction. During the encounter, the victim observed two unknown men approach the rear of the vehicle brandishing firearms. The victim and the acquaintance quickly drove out of the area as the suspects began firing rounds towards them. At some point the victim was struck by one of the rounds and was driven to an area hospital where police were contacted. The victim was treated for non-life threatening injuries. While canvassing the above area, officers located spent shell casings on the ground. No additional injuries or property damage were reported.

**Carjacking** – On October 8 at 5:30PM, officers responded to the 2400 block of Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The victim, a 33-year-old woman, reported to police she and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation. During the encounter, the accused forced the victim out of her vehicle before driving off. While investigating, the vehicle was returned to the victim by another acquaintance. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Shane Dareon **POLLARD**. Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

**Armed Robbery** – On October 9 at 4:53PM, officers responded to the Wells Fargo located at 8441 Sudley Rd. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a robbery. The victim, a 27-year-old man, reported to police that he was approached by a masked man while inside the vestibule area using the ATM. During the encounter, the man brandished a firearm and demanded the victim's money. The suspect took the victim's money and threatened him before fleeing the area. No injuries were reported. A police K-9 searched the area for the suspect who was not located.

***Suspect Description:***

A Hispanic male, around 20 years of age, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt, light-colored pants, and a yellow surgical-style mask

**Sexual Assault Investigation** – On October 10 at 10:46PM, officers responded to investigate an assault that was reported to have occurred in the 5000 block of Softwood Ln. in Woodbridge (22192) sometime between 5:00PM and 6:00PM. The victim, a 19-year-old woman, reported to police that she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the man inappropriately touched the victim before she was able to push him away. The suspect then pulled down his pants and exposed himself to the victim before she left the area. The victim eventually contacted the police. No injuries were reported.

A black male, possibly between 35-45 years of age, approximately 6'00", 230-240lbs., with short black hair and a full beard

## Arrests

**Abduction | Malicious Wounding | Domestic Related** – On October 11 at 4:53AM, officers responded to the 10700 block of Battlevue Pkwy in Manassas (20109) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 28-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, drove to the above area where a verbal altercation escalated. During the encounter, the accused pulled the victim from the vehicle and threw her on the ground where he then laid on top of her, preventing her from leaving. At one point, the accused grabbed the victim's throat before grabbing a rock and striking her in the face multiple times. The accused then took the victim's phone before driving away in the vehicle. The victim contacted the police and was transported to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. While investigating, officers determined that the accused was driving on a revoked license. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Tyrone Divaughn Thomas **HOLLOMAN**. On October 12, the accused was taken into custody without incident.

The investigation revealed that the victim, a 27-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim before grabbing her and taking her keys to prevent her from leaving. An off-duty Virginia State Trooper intervened and separated the parties. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Steven Camryn **KIRK**, was arrested.

**Strangulation | Domestic Related** – On October 9 at 4:20AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 13400 block of Nascoby Ln. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic. The victim, a 40-year-old woman, reported to police that earlier that morning she and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation. During the encounter, the accused pushed the victim against the wall and grabbed her throat. Eventually the parties separated, and the accused fled the area. The victim reported minor injuries. During the investigation, the victim reported a previous incident on October 6, where the accused struck the victim before grabbing her throat. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Dominic Eugene **WRIGHT**, who turned himself in to police the following day.

**Abduction | Strangulation | Domestic Related** – On October 8 at 8:23PM, officers responded to the Rimpal Inn located at 7399 Old Centreville Rd. in Manassas (20111) to investigate a domestic. The investigation revealed that the victim, a 25-year-old woman, was involved in a verbal altercation with an acquaintance, identified as the accused, when the accused threw her onto the bed and grabbed her throat. During the encounter, the accused also prevented the victim from leaving the room. A witness intervened and the accused fled prior to police arriving at the hotel. The victim reported minor injuries. While investigating, the accused returned to the above location and was taken into custody without incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Marlo **SOSA BUSTILLO**, was arrested.



**Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]** – On October 9 at 2:20AM, officers responded to Bar Louie located at 15001 Potomac Town Pl. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a fight. Upon arrival, officers encountered a woman who was in a verbal altercation with other acquaintances. At some point during the investigation, the woman, later identified as the accused, was determined to be intoxicated. As officers attempted to take her into custody, she actively resisted and refused to follow officer's commands. Eventually, officers were able to place the accused into custody. As officers were escorting the accused to a police vehicle, she began to resist again. At one point, she kicked an officer in the upper body before being re-secured and placed inside the police vehicle without further incident. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Lindsay Nicole **DIAMOND**, was arrested.
