

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE 2022 NATIONAL HEALTHY LIVING SUMMIT

The current COVID surge and omicron variant have introduced new complexities as states begin to plan their travel to and participation in the National 4-H Healthy Living Summit, scheduled for February 10-13, 2022. After consulting with Extension leadership and the Healthy Living Summit planning team, Council has postponed the National 4-H Healthy Living Summit to April 21-24, 2022. The deadline to register has been extended to April 4, 2022. Any participant currently registered for the Summit who is unable to attend during the new April dates will receive a full refund.

Civic Engagement and National 4-H Conference Scholarship Deadline Extended

Dates: March 19-24, 2022

Location: Hyatt Regency, Crystal City, VA

National 4 H Conference is the pinnacle experience in 4 H Civic Engagement, providing the opportunity for young people to connect, learn, engage, lead and impact their communities, nation and world. At the conference, delegates will have the opportunity to participate in round table discussions and present to federal

partner agencies along with the opportunity for delegates to engage with their U.S. Senators and Representatives.

The 2022 National 4-H Conference dates will be held in a hybrid format on March 20-24. The hybrid option will allow youth to attend either in-person at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City at Reagan National Airport or attend virtually through an online conference platform. The registration fee for in-person attendance will be \$1,095 for youths and \$1,195 for adults. The in-person registration fee will include hotel lodging, most meals, transportation at Conference, a 4-H mask and a 4-H polo shirt (travel costs to and from the conference are not included). The fee for virtual attendance will be \$425 for youths and adults. The virtual registration fee will include conference access, a virtual agency visit, activities for virtual attendees, 4-H mask, a 4-H polo shirt and 4 -H swag box. The State 4-H Office will offset a portion of the registration fee. This portion will be determined after the delegates have been selected.

NEW this year, we are opening this opportunity to all teens ages 15 - 18 across the Commonwealth. We ask that interested youth complete an application process that can be accessed at: https://forms.gle/S6BNTAM7pRIUAfDH6. The application deadline is next Tuesday, February 15th at 12:00 Noon.

From our Friends at VT: VT Research: The Intersection of Technology, Exercise, and Nutrition for Horses



Equine Enthusiasts: Kyla Szemplinski's research explores inertial measurement unit (IMU) sensors with horses. She is a Ph.D. student at Virginia Tech's Middleburg Agriculture Research & Extension Center (AREC). Her studies focus on the intersection of technology, exercise, and nutrition for horses. Her goal is to identify uses for IMUs that improve peoples' everyday interactions with their horses. She has asked for help obtaining feedback from pleasure horse owners about their use or awareness of wearable IMU sensors.

Please take a few minutes to complete a survey that Kyla developed. The results will provide her insight into additional everyday uses for wearable sensors that one day might become a



Challenge your culinary skills! The **Prince William 4-H Food**Challenge is an exciting opportunity for youth to learn how to prepare nutritious and safe meals and snacks and adopt behaviors that can help reduce their risk for chronic disease. This contest challenges teams of 3-4 4-H members to create a dish using only a predetermined set of ingredients within 40 minutes. From these ingredients, team members must identify and prepare the dish, then present it to a team of judges.

GOALS

- To exhibit knowledge and skill when preparing and presenting a dish
- To utilize teamwork and leadership skills
- To demonstrate public speaking skills

HOW ARE TEAMS JUDGED

Teams are judged on preparation and presentation to encourage learning and improvement based on a National 4-H rubric. Judging categories include: knowledge of *MyPlate*, nutrition knowledge, food preparation, safety practices, serving size, food appearance and quality, creativity, communications, and ability to respond to questions.
