The Prince William Health District What You Should Know

Self-Testing At Home or Anywhere

Self-tests for COVID-19 give rapid results and **can be taken anywhere**, regardless of your vaccination status or whether or not you have symptoms.

- They detect **current** infection and are sometimes also called "home tests," "athome tests," or "over-the-counter (OTC) tests."
- They give your **result in a few minutes** and are different from laboratory-based tests that may take days to return your result.
- Self-tests along with <u>vaccination</u>, <u>wearing a well-fitted mask</u>, and physical distancing, help <u>protect you and others</u> by reducing the chances of spreading COVID-19.
- Self-tests **do not** detect antibodies which would suggest a previous infection and they do not measure your level of immunity. Free tests are also available through <u>local health departments</u>. **Order free tests** at <u>COVIDtests.gov</u>
- **Buy tests** online or in pharmacies and retail stores. Private health insurance may reimburse the cost of purchasing self-tests. Visit <u>FDA's website</u>
