#### TSA To Keep Mask Directive Into April

• Mask Use on Public Transportation - After recommendation from the CDC, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) is extending the security directive for mask use on public transportation and transportation hubs for one month, through April 18. During the extension, CDC will work with government agencies to help inform a revised policy framework for when, and under what circumstances, masks should be required in the public transportation corridor. This revised framework will be based on COVID-19 community levels, risk of new variants, national data, and the latest science. Any updates will be communicated publicly if and/or when they change. The security directive was set to expire on March 18.

# Prince William Health Department will discontinue CTC+ Testing Services

#### All other testing events will continue

Prince William Health District (PWHD) will discontinue the Community CTC+, the vendor operated van established for COVID-19 testing. The initiative will end this Saturday March 12, 2022 due to a decrease in requests for testing from the community. The other testing events and services provided by the Prince William Health District and community partners will continue.
