 - The Housing Trust Fund Homeless Reduction Grant (HTF-HRG) will be included in the Homeless & Special Needs Housing (HSNH) Grant Community Application. (see attached)
 - The HTF-HRG will include RRH, PSH, and Underserved Innovation Projects. Information on Housing Trust Fund begins on page 7. Multiple projects and project types can be submitted in this section of the application.
 - There is no cap on the amount that can be requested for each project. While HTF-HRG is included in the HSNH application cycle, funding for those projects will still be released on the calendar year (January 1 - December 31, 2023).
 - o Funding allocations will be determined by the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) and \$8 million allotted in housing for Virginia.

VHSP Application Timeline

- An email will be sent to all the participants (applications will be released on February 15, 2022, and due February 28, 2022, at 12 p.m.)
 - o The PWA CoC Application will be submitted by the end of March 2022.
 - Proposed Grantees (HTF): HTF-HRG will be awarded to eligible RRH, PSH, and Underserved Innovation projects as a bonus based on this funding application. Projects will be selected based on the CoC/LPG's need for funding and performance.
 - o In the narrative section, there are details of each eligible proposed project using the following format: Organization Name, Project Type (RRH or PSH), Funding Request (total amount), Total number of households to be served, Brief description of proposed project including proposed activities.
 - The funds could be used for one of three services: Rapid Rehousing, Permanent Supportive Housing and Housing Location.

Veterans Report

- April Ballard Operation Renewed Hope Foundation (ORHF) made the following announcements:
 - o Reviewed Homeless Veterans By-Names and asked for updates and additions. The updated list will be emailed to the committee after the meeting.
 - Committee members discussed the Veterans Homeless By-Names list to be discussed line by line due to confidentiality concerns. A copy of ROI will be submitted to committee facilitator for review.
 - VASH (Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing) vouchers are still available in the community. Referrals are made through the VA Northern Virginia Outreach Social Worker. Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) providers can help facilitate referrals for veterans enrolled in SSVF.

Rapid Re-housing

- Process and Paperwork
 - o Program Manager Jeanine Gravette conducted a training on RRH and all the required documentation to include the following:
 - > PWA Permanent Housing Referral Summary Sheet
 - > PWA CoC Intake Form
 - ➤ Housing Targeting Assessment Tool
 - ➤ HMIS Notice & Consent to Share Information
 - ➤ VI-SPDAT Score
 - Consent for the Release of Confidential Information
 - ➤ Homeless Certification Form and supporting documentation
 - Rapid Rehousing Prioritization Tool Points
- Homeless Management Information Systems (HMIS)
 - Alicia La Patra reviewed client consent and homeless certification:
 - ➤ The HMIS Release of Information (ROI) is completed and uploaded at project intake and should exist in the system prior to referrals being made except for providers completing "Community Referrals" who will complete the ROI at the point of referral.
 - o HMIS ROIs allow for data sharing within the system.

- HMIS ROIs are required for all adults 18+ and are good for two years from the date they are signed.
- The "Third-Party" consent form is completed at the point for data sharing <u>outside of HMIS.</u>
- ➤ Providers may use project entry assessments from HMIS as supporting documentation on the Homeless Certification Form.
- ➤ CoC and HMIS guides, referral packets, and policy documents are hosted in HMIS and instructions on how to access these are posted under "System News."

CES Policies and Procedures Manual Plan

- The CES Policies and Procedures manual will be emailed to the committee on February 7, 2022, for review.
- Two meetings will occur every month (Meeting #1: Held every first Thursday of every month Veteran's report will be discussed, other agenda items, along with CES policies and procedures. Meeting #2: Held every third Thursday of every month to go over the policy and procedures).
