






4-H Shooting Education Camp at the Holiday Lake 4-H Center



- Helping to write and edit the bi-monthly Buzz, Body, and Bites Newsletter for Teens.
- Embodying the role of a Healthy Living Ambassador by being the youth voice in your community to advocate for healthy living.
- Informing 4-H youth, volunteers, and others about 4-H Healthy Living opportunities and resources.


4-H Clubs are open to youth ages 5-19. They can be established in-school, after school, or as independent clubs, and can be teacher or volunteer led.
