


Virginia 4-H: Scarf Campaign is Underway!

We have some great news to share with you. The Shooting Education Camp for 2023 will now be held on July 30 - August 3, 2023. That means many youth members can now attend the camp before school starts. The camp is open to boys and girls ages 12 to 16. Participants will receive 4 days of instruction related to their chosen discipline, consisting of such topics as Shooting Safety Education, Shooting Fundamentals and Theory, and Marksmanship Instruction. Each will have the opportunity to participate in one or more competitive shoots. Disciplines offered include: Archery, Muzzleloading, Pistol, Shotgun, Small Bore Rifle (.22), & Air Rifle.
