Urgent Request for PW 4-H Shooting Sports



We need your help in securing a meeting location for over 100 (youth and adults) enrolled members in Trigger Time 4-H Club. Trigger Time has had the generous benefit of utilizing space at the Prince William County Fairgrounds for indoor air sports shooting practices for over 15 years. While our space did become more limited in recent years, we have still been fortunate to have an indoor space with lights, heat, and restroom facilities with no output of rental fees. Use of a space that allows club members to be together promotes

opportunities for mentorship of new members by older or more experienced club members, opportunities for youth to make new friends, families to connect, and volunteers to support each other while teaching our youth valuable life skills. For the upcoming 4-H year, Trigger Time 4-H Club will not have the ability to use any of the building at the Prince William County Fairgrounds for air sport practices. This is a great loss for a large and very active club.

We are reaching out to the entire 4-H membership and past members too, to ask for your help in spreading the word and helping in our search for a new facility. You can shoot air guns almost anywhere and the club has the proper backstops and safety equipment needed to move into almost any facility. The question is, where could that be? The ideal indoor space would have electricity for lights, heat (as these disciplines meet during the winter months), and ideally, restrooms. A building/structure that is 45' x 120' could accommodate the space needs for the club as the enrollment stands today.

When horse pastures are managed properly it can lead to good nutrition for your horses, reduced feed cost, and stewardship of the land. Specialists from Virginia Tech, University of Kentucky and local Extension Agents will speak on Forage Management, Weed Control, Soils and Nutrient Management, Composting, Soil Erosion, and Partner Resources. There will be time for consultation with agents to build your own pasture management plan. As part of the course, there will be a visit to a local farm. This event will allow for networking and building relationships with horse owners throughout the area. It enables us to learn more about equine pasture management together.

The Shooting Education Camp for 2023 will be held on July 30 - August 3, 2023. The camp is open to boys and girls ages 12 to 16. Participants will receive 4 days of instruction related to their chosen discipline, consisting of such topics as Shooting Safety Education, Shooting Fundamentals and Theory, and Marksmanship Instruction. Each will have the opportunity to participate in one or more competitive shoots. Disciplines offered include: Archery, Muzzleloading, Pistol, Shotgun, Small Bore Rifle (.22), and Air Rifle. Teen Assistants, aged 17-20, with 4H Shooting Education experience, are also needed for the camp.



NRA Foundation Grant Application

Virginia 4-H Shooting Education Instructors Recertification

Shooting Education Instructors must be Recertified every 7 years in each discipline they are certified to instruct. This is a requirement to comply with the National Standards published by the National 4-H Shooting Sports Committee. There are approximately 160 instructors that need to be recertified in one or more disciplines. Those that have not completed recertification by the 12/31/2023 deadline will be de-certified. There are 3 sessions remaining before the deadline: November 5, 2022; February 2023; and November 2023. Due to space, registration is limited.
