



Every year, in May, law professionals across the nation celebrate Law Day to cultivate a deeper understanding of the legal profession and role of the law in society.

This year, the Clerk of the Circuit Court, Jacqueline Smith, Esq. is hosting her 3rd Annual Law Day Art Contest. All students and schools in Prince William County, and the Cities of Manassas and Manassas Park are invited to submit artwork that inspire the decision making necessary to address the challenges that face our nation.

The Clerk’s Call for Student Artwork implores the American Bar Association’s Law Day Theme: “Cornerstones of Democracy: Civics, Civility, and Collaboration”. An interlacing of civics and art, the intention for the Clerk’s Law Day art contest is to provide an exciting and educational way to enhance civil discourse and decision making within the community.

The Clerk of Circuit Court encourages all students in grades 1st-12th enrolled in all local (private, home, public) schools in Prince William County, and the Cities of Manassas and Manassas Park to submit artwork illustrating the Cornerstones of Democracy: Civics, Civility, and Collaboration.


