- A. APPROVE REVISED FEE FOR SUBSTANCE USE SCREENINGS **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1. 2023, AND CONTINUE TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO UPDATE THE FEE SCHEDULE IN THE** EVENT OF MEDICAID OR MEDICARE FEE CHANGES OR ADDITIONS
- **B. RECOMMEND THE PRINCE WILLIAM BOARD OF COUNTY** SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZE COMMUNITY SERVICES TO APPLY FOR THE OPIOID ABATEMENT AUTHORITY FUNDS, AND CONTINENT **UPON AWARD, ACCEPT, BUDGET, AND APPROPRIATE \$800,000 OPIOID ABATEMENT AND \$230,000 MEDICAID ONE-TIME STATE** REVENUE TO FISCAL YEARS 2024 – 2028 FOR A TOTAL OF \$5,150,000 FOR OFFICE-BASED OPIOID TREATMENT SERVICES
