4.6.3 Insulation Certificate

This establishes the requirements for installing a permanent **Residential Insulation Certificate** in new Residential Construction.

1. Approved Insulation Certificate

- A. The Builder can utilize the County **Residential Insulation Certificate** on our Building Development Forms Management System or,
- B. The Builder may use their own Residential Insulation Certification if it meets the minimum standards of the current edition of the Virginia Residential Code, Chapter 11 Energy Efficiency.

2. Approved Location of Certificate

The <u>Residential Insulation Certificate</u> shall be located on a wall in the space where the furnace is located, a utility room, or an approved location inside the building. Where located on an electrical panel, the certificate shall not cover or obstruct the visibility of the circuit directory label, service disconnect label, or other required labels.
