## **New Business:**

- Dr. E Porta discussed general procedural layout of future meetings going forward that will be included and implemented.
- Dr. E Porta discussed sharing standard verbal reports of county efforts at each meeting. G Manno will be providing updates from the county Office of Sustainability and J Weimer from the county schools.
- Dr. E Porta discussed how the potential procedure for raising issues should be implemented. Members gave recommendations on how those issues should be raised and presented to the body.
