The Virginia 4-H Pork Challenge challenges youth to create a dish using only a predetermined set of ingredients. This contest is being offered through grant funding received by the Virginia Pork Council. Similar to the 4-H Food Challenge and the Virginia 4-H Beef Challenge, this contest will allow participants to use their creativity to create a dish using pork as the main ingredient.



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Military Teen Adventure Camps Offered at Virginia 4-H Educational Centers


