## TRIGGER TIME 4-H SHOOTING EDUCATION CLUB DEFEATS LAFAYETTE GUN CLUB

Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club defeated Lafayette Gun Club 1105.0 to 1016.7 in the 2023 National Sporter Air Rifle League. Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club was led by Samantha Seagle who shot a 290.4. The remaining contributing members were Samantha Erick who shot a 277, Rebecca Ahrens who

shot a 271, and Lexi Strand who shot a 266.6. They are from Bristow, VA, and are coached by Alan Lerch. Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club is competing in the Champions Division where they are currently ranked in tenth place. Within the Junior Rifle Club Conference they are in first place. They have a I - 0 record. Lafayette Gun Club was led by Alexandra Orr who shot a 272.0. The remaining contributing members were Makayla Sigler, Christina Morris, and Hudson Monteith. Lafayette Gun Club is from Grafton, VA, and is coached by Mark Teixeira.

Next up Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club will compete against American Legion Post 290 from Stafford, VA.


