3 of the 34 are Venomous Pit-vipers


- Timber Rattlesnake

## Eastern Copperhead (Venomous)





### Identifying a Venomous Snake by Head Shape and Eye Pupils

Using a snake's head shape and/or Eye Pupil is an unreliable method for determining whether a snake is venomous or not. Know the Pattern!






Venomous Timber Rattlesnake

#### Head Shape

The two photos below are of the same juvenile eastern ratsnake. The left-side image depicts the snake with its head in a defensive posture. This makes the snake look larger and more formidable to potential predators. The right-side image shows the snake in a non-defensive posture with the head in its normal shape.

• Roughly 8,000 people are bitten by venomous snakes each year in the US with a small percent being fatal


- In contrast, 20,000 people die every year from the side • effects of aspirin.
- Most venomous snake bites occur when untrained individuals try to pick them up, try to remove them, or try to kill them.
- If bitten, you should NOT try to kill the snake and bring it with you. However, It is a good idea to take a picture of the snake so it can be accurately identified.
- Venomous snake bites are immediate medical emergencies, and they can be deadly if not treated quickly.

#### If bitten by a venomous snake in Virginia:

- DO NOT become over-exerted
- DO NOT apply a tourniquet
- DO NOT apply a cold compress DO NOT cut into the bite with a knife
- DO NOT try to suck the venom out by mouth
- DO NOT take any medications

## **Snake Best Practices**

#### Things you can do to "Limit" snakes from coming onto your property...

- Mow your grass often and keep it short
- Avoid (or limit) watering your lawn
- Keep trees and landscape trimmed
- Relocate the bird feeder away from house
- Install a perch pole for predators to use
- Feed pets inside
- Relocate wood, brush and compost piles away from house
- Think before you landscape (koi ponds, water features, using mulch, large rocks)
- Seal up cracks in foundation, under sidewalks and porches
- Use of water hose
- Fencing Options

## Succeeds with Sustainability

### Encountering a Snake on your Property:



### What should I do?

- Identify the snake species to ensure that it is not venomous.
- Leave it alone, eventually the snake will move on.
- Use a non-sharp tool to discourage or help the snake move on.
- Use a water hose if available to spray and deter the snake away.
- If these options do not work, call an expert to have the snake removed properly.

#### What NOT to do?

- NEVER kill a snake!
- It is illegal to kill a snake in the state of Virginia.
- Killing a snake does not keep more snake away.
- Do not keep a wild snake as a pet; keep wildlife in the wild where it belongs!

### **Snake Sustainability**

#### Never give up!

The snake pictured below was found in a trash bag next to a customer trash can. The snake had been stomped multiple times, causing a torn jugular vein, a hole in her trachea, a protruding eye, several lacerations and broken ribs.
