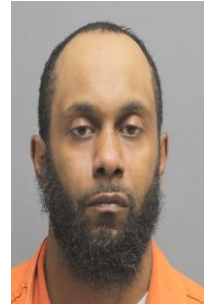
Strong-Armed Robbery *ARREST – On March 12, 2024, the suspect, identified as Derrick **WANZER**, who was sought in connection to the robbery that was reported to have occurred in the 5000 block of Wellington Rd. in Gainesville (20155) on December 7, 2022, was arrested.

Strong-Armed Robbery [Previously Released] – On December 7 at 5:53PM, officers responded to investigate an assault that was reported to have occurred at the 5000 block of Wellington Rd. in Gainesville (20155) earlier that day. The investigation revealed the victim, a 35-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation while parked in the above parking lot. The altercation escalated and the accused struck the victim before taking her phone. After a short time, the victim got out of her vehicle and the accused drove the vehicle out of the area. The victim reported the incident to a family member who contacted the police. The victim reported minor injuries. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Derrick **WANZER**. Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation – On March 13, crash investigators were notified of a pedestrian who died after being struck while moving a trailer in the parking lot of 5 County Complex Ct. in Woodbridge (22193) at approximately 3:54PM on March 7. The investigation revealed a 66-year-old man was carrying a small trailer from one vehicle to another by hand through a gravel portion of the parking lot when he tripped and fell. The trailer continued moving and rolled on top of the man's upper body and leg. Eventually, the man freed himself and was transported to an area hospital where he was released a few days later. On March 12, the victim experienced complications from the crash and was transported to the hospital where he died later that day as a result of injuries sustained from the initial incident. Due to the crash and injuries occurring in a municipal parking lot, the incident has been classified as a fatal crash.

Identified:

The deceased was identified as Peter Geoffrey **OLDERSHAW**, 66, of Woodbridge

Reckless Handling of a Firearm – On March 13 at 5:59PM, officers responded to the 17400 block of Isle Royale Ter. in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed multiple shots were fired before several men were seen fleeing the area in multiple vehicles. No injuries or property damage were reported. Shell casings were recovered along the roadway. The suspects were described as black males wearing all dark-colored clothing. The vehicles involved were a 2-door white Ford Mustang, a 2-door black Ford Mustang, a 4-door grey sedan, and a 4-door black sedan.

Arrests

Strong-Arm Robbery – On March 6 at 5:21PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 4500 block of Evansdale Rd. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, and a family member, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation over a vehicle, that escalated. During the encounter the accused struck the victim several times before he forcibly took the victim's keys and drove out of the area. No injuries were reported. Further investigation revealed the vehicle belonged to another family member who did not give the accused permission to drive the vehicle. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Kevin **CRUZ LOPEZ**, who was taken into custody on March 12 without incident.
