DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

Incidents

Armed Robbery – On March 14 at 11:15AM, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred at the Broadstone at River Oaks Apartments located in the 3100 block of Chesapeake Dr. in Dumfries (22026) at approximately 7:30PM on March 13. The investigation revealed the victim, a 20-year-old man, was inside an apartment with a group of acquaintances when one of the acquaintances brandished a firearm and demanded the victim's firearm. During the encounter, the suspects took the victim's firearm, and the victim eventually left the apartment. At no point during the encounter were any shots fired and no injuries were reported. The investigation continues as detectives attempt to identify the suspects involved in the incident.

Residential Burglary – On March 14 at 12:49PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 7500 block of Alleghany Rd. in Manassas (20111) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between 4:00PM on March 13 and 12:00PM on March 14, entry was made into the basement area of the home through an unsecured door. An undisclosed amount of money was reported missing.

Arrests

Attempted Malicious Wounding on School Grounds – On March 4, at 2:09PM, the School Resource Officer (SRO) assigned to Hylton High School, located at 14051 Spriggs Rd. in Woodbridge (22193), was notified of a fight between students inside the school. The investigation revealed a female student, identified as the accused, approached another student, a 15-year-old female juvenile, and struck her multiple times. The parties were separated by school staff and the victim was treated by the school nurse for minor injuries. During the investigation, the SRO determined the accused was holding a metal key in her hand while striking the victim. On March 13, following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **16-year-old female juvenile**, was arrested.

Strong-Arm Robbery – On March 14 at 3:21PM, officers responded to the 4300 block of Evergreen Dr. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, was walking in the above area when he was approached from behind by two unknown male juveniles, one later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the suspects struck the victim and took his Balenciaga shoes before fleeing on foot. While investigating the incident, officers identified the accused and detained him without incident. The victim reported minor injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **15-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested. The investigation remains active as officers attempt to identify the second suspect involved in the incident. The suspect is described as a Hispanic male with curly hair last seen wearing a bandana on his head and a grey hooded sweatshirt.
