### Incidents

**Attempted Strong-Arm Robbery** – On March 31 at 7:50PM, officers responded to the 1900 block of Daniel Stuart Sq. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 10-year-old male juvenile, was approached by a group of individuals believed to be juveniles. During the encounter, one of the juveniles struck the victim and attempted to take his phone. The suspects were unable to take the victim’s phone before fleeing on foot. The victim was treated to an area hospital with minor injuries. The suspects were described as both male and female juveniles wearing black clothing.

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm** – On March 30 at 9:12AM, officers responded to investigate a shots fired call that was reported to have occurred in the 1900 block of Horner Rd. in Woodbridge (22191) sometime overnight. The investigation revealed multiple gunshots were heard around 3:14AM. Later that morning, shell casings were located on the roadway. No injuries or other property damage were reported.

**Malicious Wounding (Domestic)** – On March 31 at 3:06AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 3100 block of Arrowhead Ct. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 39-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused cut the victim with a knife before the victim fled the home. The victim was treated at an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Merly Estefani **FERNANDEZ AMAYA**, was arrested.

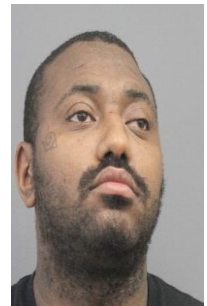
**Strangulation (Domestic)** – On March 31 at 12:17AM, officers responded to investigate a domestic dispute that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 13100 block of Rock Ridge Ln. in Woodbridge (22191) on the evening of January 14. The investigation revealed the victim, a 33-year-old woman and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated when the accused struck and strangled the victim. While investigating the incident, the victim reported between November 2023 and March 2024, there were two additional altercations where the accused struck the victim. The victim reported sustaining minor injuries during each incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Cristian **CASTRO ISUIZA**, was arrested.

**Strangulation (Domestic)** – On March 29 at 9:55PM, officers responded to the Coverstone 4 Apartments located in the 7600 block of Croce Ct. in Manassas (20109) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 32-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused grabbed the victim's neck and then threw her towards a wall before the parties separated. Minor injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Darren Joey-Deshawn **WASHINGTON**, was arrested.

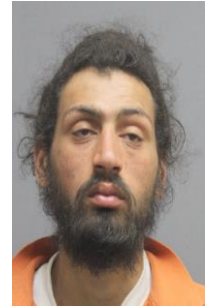

The accused was also found in possession of suspected illegal narcotics. The officers reported minor injuries. **Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]** – On March 29 at 3:10PM, officers responded to the 7700 block of Sudley Rd. in Manassas (20109) to assist fire and rescue personnel on a medical call. When officers arrived on the scene, the party involved, later identified as the accused, was in their vehicle and drove off, striking a fire truck and utility pole at a nearby intersection. The accused attempted to strike an officer before additional officers arrived and detained the accused. While the accused was being treated at an area hospital for intoxication, he kicked a hospital staff member. Minor injuries were reported by the staff member. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Mark Edwards **DAVIDSON**, was arrested.
