Milk Jug Gardening Update: Transplanting Seedlings

Mrs. Hardin at PW 4-H Headquarters has successfully grown asclepius seedlings! Her seedlings have 4 true leaves and were ready to be transplanted. Mrs. Hardin used the new fork method that she learned at CAUSES in DC to separate the milkweed, carefully transplanted them into her garden, and thoroughly watered to help them grow. Most types of milkweed do best in full sun, about 1-2 feet apart, and will tolerate clay soil and temporary flooding.

Milkweed is a beneficial plant to add to gardens. Monarch butterflies lay their eggs on milkweed





because it is the only food source for their caterpillars, making it crucial for their survival. Pollinators love milkweed flowers, and so do hummingbirds.
