The Danish awards system will be used at all levels of competition (scored against a rubric). Blue ribbons are awarded to competitors earning 90-100 points; red ribbons are awarded to competitors earning 75-89 points; white ribbons are awarded to competitors earning 74 points or less.

Districts award a purple ribbon to the highest scoring youth in the category. Each District may submit no more than one act in each contest/category. At the state contest, the highest scoring act in each contest/category will be awarded a project medal.

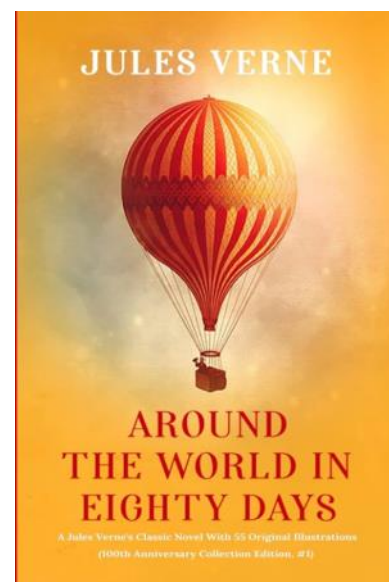

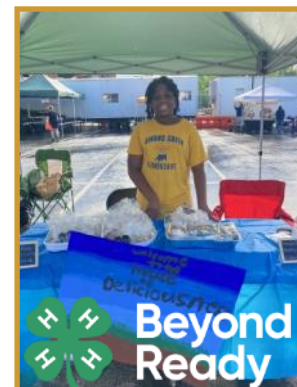

Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club Team - Champions of the 33rd American Legion Department of Virginia State Championship!

April 30, 2025. On April 26th, Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club's sporter air rifle team competed in the 33rd Annual American Legion Department of Virginia State Championship. In March, postal matches were held for three different regions of Virginia. The top teams from each of these regions were invited to the State Championship. In total, nine teams representing five American Legion Posts qualified for the competition. Representing the team were Rebecca Ahrens (550), Lexi Strand (548), Tanner Ridings (538), and Samantha Holmes (508). Ayden Strand was the team alternate, scoring 529. Out of the five Trigger Time members, two scored personal records: Tanner Ridings and Ayden Strand. Rebecca Ahrens placed 3rd as an individual and Trigger Time claimed the title of 33rd American Legion Department of Virginia State Champion and received a trophy for their 1st place ranking.

Applications are now open for senior Virginia 4-H'ers to participate in 2025 National 4-H Congress. For more than 100 years, National 4-H Congress has served as the premiere educational and recognition event for senior 4-H members. National Congress provides participants an exciting opportunity to explore careers, engage in a variety of quality learning experiences, and have great fun by getting to know other 4-H members from across the country. Outstanding 4-H members will be selected to represent Virginia at National 4-H Congress. Candidates for selection must be senior 4-H members in the current 4-H year who are able to demonstrate outstanding achievement as a 4-H member in the areas of leadership, citizenship, and personal development.

During this submission process, applicants will be asked to submit their cover letter, resume, three letters of recommendation, and a photo.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Virginia 4-H values the life skills that members develop through personal record keeping. An electronic 4-H portfolio, which replaced the 4-H Achievement Record, will serve as the foundation for a 4-H member's application to participate in National 4-H Congress, if selected for an interview. The formal process includes two steps, which are intended to provide the 4-H member learning exercises that reflect an employment application and interview procedure:

1. The submission of a written personal resume; and
2. For those selected to interview, a presentation of an electronic personal portfolio (detailed information on the electronic portfolio will be provided to all youth selected to be interviewed)

Those selected for an interview will need a working Gmail account, as electronic portfolios will be submitted through Google Classroom.

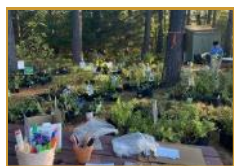
