

### **Draft Noise Ordinance Adoption Timeline**

- **April 16:** DCOAG meeting (discuss the draft noise scales, finalize the noise survey questions and response, and finalize plans for the noise testing at Great Oak)
- **April 18/19/20:** Great Oak Noise Test at one location
- **April 21:** Obtain second noise meter
- **April 22:** Board to approve \$35K funding for noise consultation services
- **April 23:** DCOAG meeting (we won't have our consultants on Board or any of the Noise testing analysis results from Great Oak, but can continue discussions about the noise scales, and discuss feedback from Les Bloomberg)
- **April 25:** Modified Task Order approved for Nelson Acoustics. Purchase Order approved with Rutgers University (Eric Zwerling)
- **April 25/26/27:** Great Oak Noise Testing at two locations
- **April 28 – May 2:** Meeting with Nelson Acoustics, JMT, Eric Zwerling and County staff.
- **April 30:** DCOAG meeting (Mosley may be ready to meet and discuss the Zoning conceptual ideas. Noise data analysis from Great Oak will not be ready)
- **May 5:** Data from Great Oak Noise Testing sent to DCOAG
- **May 7:** DCOAG meeting (Discuss Great Oak Noise Test results/Meet with Eric Zwerling to get his thoughts on our draft Ordinance and Enforcement)
- **May 14:** DCOAG Meeting (Discuss final edits to the draft Noise Ordinance)
- **May 15:** Final edits and changes to the Noise Ordinance are due
- **May 28:** Draft staff report, Resolution, Ordinance and presentation finalized
- **May 30:** Draft documents sent to the DCOAG for review
- **June 4:** DCOAG meeting/DCOAG comments on the draft documents are due
- **June 10:** Board item (staff report, Resolution and presentation) sent to the Clerk's Office for routing
- **July 8:** Board meeting

\*\*\*During the next couple months, I will be coordinating with Public Works and the Police Department on the develop of a budget plan to manage the enforcement program. We will also be working to develop our inspection and noise testing policies and procedures documents. This will include meeting with the Commonwealth Attorney's Office to bring them up to date on the draft changes to the Ordinance and discuss the proposed enforcement process.
