Malicious Wounding (Domestic) *ARREST – On April 22, the suspect, identified as Derys Alexander **ORTIZ URQUIZA**, who was sought in connection to the malicious wounding that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 14300 block of Southgate Ct. in Woodbridge (22193) on April 20, was arrested.

Malicious Wounding (Domestic) [Previously Released] – On April 20 at 2:51AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 14300 block of Southgate Ct. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, and a family member, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused assaulted and then stabbed the victim with a knife before leaving the area. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Derys Alexander **ORTIZ URQUIZA.** Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

Commercial Burglary – On April 21 at 8:18AM, officers responded to Sentara Urgent Care located at 16422 Navigation Dr. in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between 4:00PM on April 20 and 6:50AM on April 21, entry was made into the business through an unsecured door. No property was reported missing.

Attempted Residential Burglary – On April 20 at 9:15PM, officers responded to the Princeton Woods Apartments located in the 3300 block of Yost Ln. in Dumfries (22026) to investigate an attempted burglary. Video footage revealed an unknown man threw a hard object at a window causing an alarm activation. No entry was made into the apartment, and no property was reported missing. The suspect was described as a black male with dreadlocks, wearing a white shirt, blue pants and black shoes.

Strangulation (Domestic) – On April 21 at 11:29AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 12300 block of Romney Mews in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 92-year-old woman, was assaulted multiple times by a family member, identified as the accused. During one of the encounters, the accused grabbed the victim's neck before the parties separated. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Joseph Howard **GARDNER**, was arrested.

Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO] – On April 21 at 11:22PM, officers initiated a traffic stop in the area of Malta St. near Rapid Ln. in Woodbridge (22193) for a traffic violation. During the stop, the driver of the vehicle, later identified as the accused, disregarded the officer's command and fled on foot. When officers attempted to detain the accused, he sprayed an officer with an eye-irritant before being detained without further incident. Officers determined the accused was also intoxicated and in possession of suspected illegal narcotics. An officer was treated at the scene for minor injuries. The accused was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries before being transported to the Adult Detention Center. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as David Alex **PARKHURST**, was arrested.

Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor – On April 19 at 8:14PM, officers working an off-duty detail at the Jolly Shows Carnival located at 8300 Sudley Rd. in Manassas (20109) located an unattended child. The investigation revealed the accused left her 8-year-old son unattended at the carnival. Officers were eventually able to contact the accused who later returned to the above area where she was detained. The child did not appear to be injured and was released to the custody of known parties. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Tanisha Shadai **MOSLEY**, was charged.
