Incidents

Brandishing of a Firearm [Road Rage Related] – On April 22 at 7:06PM, officers responded to the area of Minnieville Rd. near Smoketown Rd. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a brandishing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 23-year-old man, was driving on Minnieville Rd. when he was involved in a road rage incident with the driver of another vehicle. While both vehicles were traveling on Minnieville Rd., the suspect pulled up next to the victim's vehicle and brandished a firearm before the victim drove out of the area. No shots were fired, and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a flatbrimmed hat and driving a Honda Civic.

Malicious Wounding - On April 22 at 1:26PM, officers responded to the 14800 block of Dining Way in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 38-year-old man, was involved in a verbal altercation with an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused struck the victim multiple times before the parties separated. The victim was treated at an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested.

Sexual Assault Investigation – On April 22, detectives concluded an investigation into a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at a residence in the Triangle (22172) area of Prince William County between November 2024 and March 2025. The investigation revealed the victim, who was under the age of 13 at the time of the offenses, was sexually assaulted by an acquaintance, identified as the accused, on more than one occasion during the above timeframe. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Juan Edgardo **MEMBRENO AMAYA**, who on April 22 was taken into custody in Woodbridge by the U.S. Marshal's Fugitive Task Force.
