## **CMP 3PAR NATIONAL SPORTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

#### June 19-21, 2025 | Camp Perry, Ohio

June 24, 2025. Last week Trigger Time 4-H Shooting Education Club participated in the 2025 CMP 3P Sporter Air Rifle Nationals at Camp Perry in Ohio. The competition lasted over three days, followed by finals and awards. To qualify, all teams had to meet a required score in the CMP National Postal or Regional matches. In total, there were 35 teams from across the country that participated in the match, and 190 individuals.

Trigger Time placed 13th overall, and 4th under Club Teams with a combined score of 4254-108. The team members were Rebecca Ahrens (1094-33), Lexi Strand (1076-23), Tanner Ridings (1051-27), and Ayden Strand (1033-25). The team's alternate was Samantha Holmes (1046-28). Here are some of the highlights from the competition:

- ★ Samantha Holmes scored a personal match record with a 528 and earned her first three EIC Points (Excellence in Competition).
- $\star$  Ayden Strand scored a personal match record in standing with a 92.
- **★** Tanner Ridings earned three EIC Points and scored a 99 in prone.
- ★ Lexi Strand and Rebecca Ahrens met their personal goal of 550.
- \* Rebecca Ahrens placed 2nd in the under 15 age division, and earned her final EIC point, receiving her CMP Junior Distinguished Badge.

Between matches, Trigger Time members played card games, walked on the shore of Lake Erie, and ate cheeseburgers. Former team member Samantha Seagle encouraged the team and offered excellent advice. CMP hosted a giant party for all the teams with cornhole, volleyball, frisbee, and a DJ. Trigger Time enjoyed cheering on the other Virginia competitors and watching the finals. Many thanks to Coach Strand for his great leadership and ceaseless encouragement and support! Everyone had an amazing practice at Camp Perry.

DECLARATIONS ARE OPEN: ALL DECLARATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY JULY 1 AT 11:59 PM.

- ANY Horse or Pony that a youth MAY show at the State Show must be declared in 4HOnline in order to be eligible to show.
- Please be prepared when beginning your declarations with current photos of your animal, Coggins test date, and an accurate height measurement. The correct measurement is imperative, as it is tied to "Animal Type" and linked to specific classes within the entry system. If the height entered is incorrect, it will affect your ability to enter classes. If you notice your height is incorrect, you must re-add that animal as a new animal in order to input the correct measurement, the system will not allow changes.
- If you are declaring a Horse/Pony that you declared last year or in a previous year, you do have the option to re-declare a
  previously added animal. Please note, if your height/animal type is incorrect due to a previous entry error, you will need to add
  a new animal and provide all new information. There is no opportunity to change the Animal Type. Additionally, if using an
  animal from a previous year, please ensure that you upload a CURRENT Coggins Test and edit to reflect the updated Coggins
  Test date for 2025.

## Virginia 2025 Air Force 4-H Military Partnership

To be eligible for the 4-H Air Force scholarship to attend a Virginia 4-H camping event, a youth living in Virginia must have a parent/legal guardian <u>currently</u> serving in Active-Duty Air Force, Air Force Reserve, Air National Guard or Space Force.

A youth is also eligible if the military parent currently serving in another branch is stationed at an Air Force base or the youth is currently enrolled at the school age or youth center program of Joint Base Langley-Eustis.
