### What is Farm Market Fresh for Older Adults?

Older adults age 60 years or older are eligible to receive a benefit of \$50 worth of farmers' market vouchers to purchase fresh fruits, vegetables, and fresh cut herbs from approved vendors if the following statements are true:

- You are 60 years of age or older.
- You are a resident of Prince William County.
- You do not live in the same household, and you are not an immediate family member of the farmer who grows the produce.
- You meet the program's income requirements.
- You must certify your household income.

Application accepted

April 1st through September 30th

Benefit issued to eligible participants:

May 18 - September 30

Benefit can be used at farmers markets

June 1 - November 30
