Turning Gears, Shaping Futures at Virginia 4-H Congress



Prince William 4-H'ers have rested and recovered from the exciting week at Virginia 4-H Congress! What an amazing end to this year's 4-H local and district events and contests, and a kick off to a summer full of camps and state-level specialized competitions.

At the 2025 State Congress, 4-H teens across Virginia gathered to celebrate all things 4-H by "Turning Gears, Shaping Futures." Highlights of this 4-day trip included participating in presentations,

contests, and workshops, volunteering for service-learning projects, and visiting the new 4-H Teen Opportunity Fair.



Prince William 4-H had a strong representation in state-level contests. *Chop it Like It's Hot* team members Cara Grahn, Sana Canny, and Gio Castillo displayed their cooking expertise in the Virginia 4-H Food Challenge Contest. Their pork tacos looked and smelled delicious! Cara loved working with her culinary teammates, stating "I strongly encourage those teens interested in a career in food to check out 4-H Food Challenge." In Virginia 4-H Contests-Presentations, Max Comeau shared his knowledge of AI, Charlie Comeau spoke on "Procrastination" (*he only procrastinates sometimes!*), and Michael DeRoche shared "My Entrepreneurship Project." Michael participates in the Prince William 4-H Young Entrepreneurs SPIN Project where he has started a small business making soaps and selling at the Manassas Park Farmer's Market. Some of his soap molds are DRAGONS! "The judge whose face lit up from my dragons made my day," state Michael.

Tim Hirshey thoroughly enjoyed Clover Fest, the culminating event for Share the Fun participants. He said that "as a person who loves metal, the performance was awesome. I'm learning to play guitar, and people like that are why I'm trying to play."

Prince William 4-H delegate Giada Gilliam summed up our trip by saying State Congress was "a fun experience as well as practical experience. I highly recommend it."

July 9, 2025. During the past few months, members of Virginia 4-H have been practicing hard for the 2025 National 4-H Shooting Sports Championship. Participating in the competition were representatives from 31 States from across America, including Vermont, Wisconsin, Idaho, New Mexico and Mississippi. Virginia sent five teams to Grand Island, Nebraska: Smallbore Pistol, Air Pistol, Smallbore Rifle, Shotgun, and Muzzleloader. The teams were comprised of the highest scoring competitors in the State's 4-H match last September. Five members of Trigger Time qualified to represent Virginia:

AIR PISTOL: NOAH RICHTER AND AYDEN STRAND

- ★ Noah Richter placed 9th in Rapid Fire, 9th in Silhouettes, and 10th overall
- ★ Virginia's team took 4th in Rapid Fire, and 4th place overall

SMALLBORE PISTOL: NOBLE RICHTER

- ★ Noble Richter placed 3rd in Slow Fire, 3rd in Camp Perry, and 5th overall
- ★ Virginia placed 3rd in Camp Perry and 6th overall

SHOTGUN: BEN STEWART AND CHRIS NAVARR

- ★ Ben Stewart placed 2nd in Skeet
- ★ Virginia was 3rd in Skeet and 13th overall

Virginia's Smallbore team took 4th place, and the Muzzleloader team took 6th overall.

The competition lasted over the course of the week and participants had the opportunity to meet 4-H members from across the country. Trigger Time enjoyed trading state pins with other competitors, attending the teen social, and hanging out at the pool to escape the Nebraska heat.

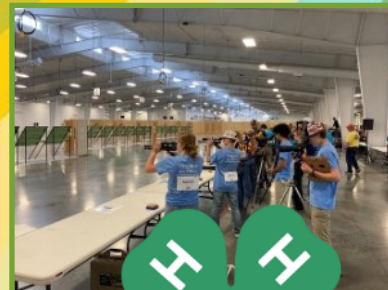

This scholarship is made possible through contributions given in memory of Constance "Connie" Collier (1946-2010). Connie spent countless hours over her lifetime to improve and promote the equine industry in Virginia, but her biggest passion was supporting youth involved in the 4-H Horse Program. Among her good works, Connie served as a 4-H Horse Club leader in Henrico County, Treasurer of the Virginia State 4-H Championship Horse and Pony Show and also played a key role in the drill team division's growth and improvement. Connie was also a Virginia 4-H alumnus and was an exhibitor in the early years of the Virginia State 4-H Championship Horse and Pony Show. Through this scholarship, we hope that Connie's lifetime commitment to the 4-H Horse Program will live on and inspire current and past exhibitors to give back to the Virginia 4-H Horse Program.

The Connie Collier 4-H Scholarship Award will provide monies to Virginia 4-H Horse Program participants who have met the 4-H Horse Program requirements and pursue post-secondary education before the age of twenty-five. Applicants must be enrolled in 4-H at the Senior Level (14 – 19) and must be enrolled in their second year of the 4-H Horse Program. Recipients shall be chosen by the Virginia 4-H Horse Program Scholarship Fund Committee through a competitive process based on the information requested in the application guidelines. Top candidates may be invited to interview as deemed necessary by the awards committee.

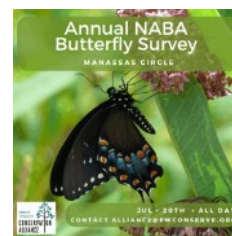

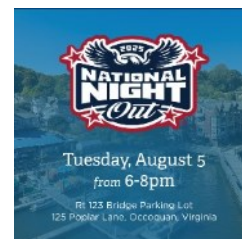

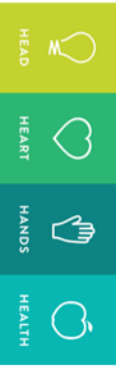
