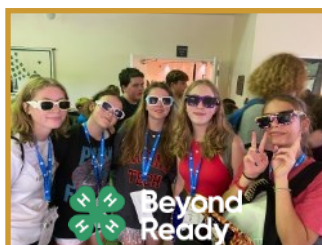

market is a new challenge, and they continue to rise, adapt, and grow into true professionals.

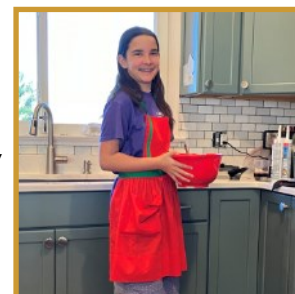

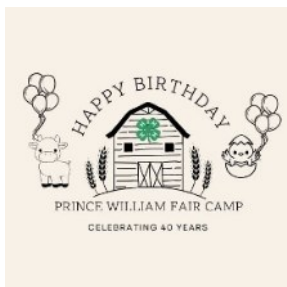

All applicants will be notified by Wednesday, September 3rd as to whether or not they have been selected for an interview. Interviews will take place in-person on the evening of Saturday, September 6th onsite at the Virginia 4-H State Shoot.

The Virginia 4-H Shooting Education Ambassador Program offers teens the opportunity to demonstrate and build upon their skills in citizenship, leadership, and public speaking as they travel around Virginia serving as advocates and spokespersons for 4-H Shooting Education. The function of this group is to help build the shooting education program in Virginia, to help its members increase their knowledge of the sport and to meet like minded youth. This is a service organization for which it is an honor to be chosen and is only as strong as its participants. Ambassadors must:

- be 14 years of age, but not over the age of 19 as of January 1, 2026
- have a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- be enrolled in 4-H and actively participating in a 4-H Shooting Ed. Program for at least 1 year
- attend and actively engage in the events as designated on the Ambassador schedule
- serve a two-year term (*renewable if selected*)
- be willing and able to take limited time off from school (*three to five days per school year*)
- If selected, pay a \$100 acceptance fee to cover programmatic resources

This scholarship is made possible through contributions given in memory of Constance "Connie" Collier (1946-2010). Connie spent countless hours over her lifetime to improve and promote the equine industry in Virginia, but her biggest passion was supporting youth involved in the 4-H Horse Program. Among her good works, Connie served as a 4-H Horse Club leader in Henrico County, Treasurer of the Virginia State 4-H Championship Horse and Pony Show and also played a key role in the drill team division's growth and improvement. Connie was also a Virginia 4-H alumnus and was an exhibitor in the early years of the Virginia State 4-H Championship Horse and Pony Show. Through this scholarship, we hope that Connie's lifetime commitment to the 4-H Horse Program will live on and inspire current and past exhibitors to give back to the Virginia 4-H Horse Program.

The Connie Collier 4-H Scholarship Award will provide monies to Virginia 4-H Horse Program participants who have met the 4-H Horse Program requirements and pursue post-secondary education before the age of twenty-five. Applicants must be enrolled in 4-H at the Senior Level (14 – 19) and must be enrolled in their second year of the 4-H Horse Program. Recipients shall be chosen by the Virginia 4-H Horse Program Scholarship Fund Committee through a competitive process based on the information requested in the application guidelines. Top candidates may be invited to interview as deemed necessary by the awards committee.

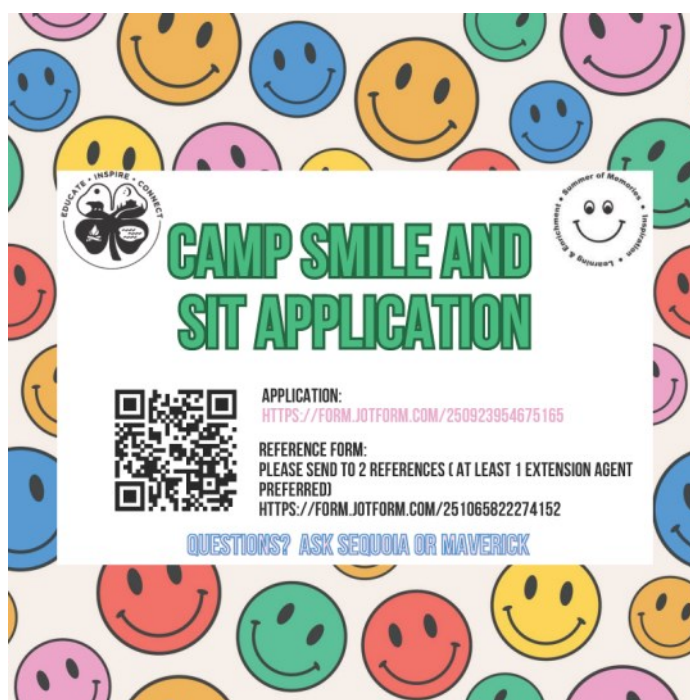

Staff in Training Program at the Northern Virginia 4-H Educational and Conference Center, which sits on 229 acres in Front Royal, Virginia and has offered Junior 4-H Camp to youth in Northern Virginia for over 40 years. Our programs stress the 4-H philosophy of “learn by doing”, which means participants are actively learning during their experiences due to full engagement in the activities. This Experiential Education leads to the development of lifelong skills. The 4-H Center is a large facility, and our average weekly number of Junior 4-H Camp participants is approximately 250 youth.

The “SIT” or Staff in Training Program, allows teens (graduating seniors) who are interested in becoming future summer camp staff members (Summer 2026) an opportunity to come back to camp and work as Camp SMILE teens or Staff in Training during the week of Camp SMILE. While SMILE teens or SIT are still responsible for nightly camper supervision and taking them from class to class, they are also given additional responsibilities. Responsibilities that may include helping the Summer Staff with classes, general camp duties, and programming assignments. Your experience as a SIT should enlighten you as to what life as a staff member is like, your potential for leadership development, and the joys of being a positive role model for youth.

All SITs who attend Camp SMILE will receive a \$100 stipend.

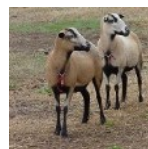

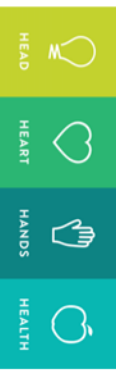
