## **PUBLIC HEARING FAQ'S**

## What is a Public Hearing?

A Public Hearing is a formal process required by County and State law or as directed by the Board. It allows residents to voice their opinions on specific issues before the Board makes a decision.

## How long can I speak?

Each speaker is allotted **three (3) minutes** to address the Board. The Board listens to speakers but does not engage in dialogue.

## Can I speak on behalf of an organization?

Yes. Representatives of a civic association, HOA, or a formally recognized organization (current with the IRS or Commonwealth of Virginia State Corporation Commission) may request **five (5) minutes** to speak. Only one representative per organization is permitted.

## Can I yield my time to another speaker?

No. Speakers may not yield their time to another person.

# How do I sign up to speak?

## **In-Person Sign-Ups**

- Sign-ups start **30 minutes before** the meeting.
- Sign-ups continue until the Chair officially closes the hearing.
- Sign-up sheets are available at the back of Board Chambers or in the McCoart atrium.
- You must provide your name, address, or Magisterial District.

## **Remote Participation (Virtual Sign-Ups)**

- Register by **5:00 PM the day before** the meeting at <u>pwcgov.granicusideas.com</u>.
- IT staff will verify remote speakers when they join the meeting.
- Speakers are called in the order they registered.
- Verified participants may disconnect and rejoin while the hearing is ongoing.
- In-person speakers speak before virtual speakers.
- Residents of Prince William County are called before non-residents.

# **Public Comment Time FAQ'S**

#### What is Public Comment Time?

Public Comment Time allows individuals to address the Board on general topics unrelated to a scheduled public hearing.

#### How long can I speak?

Each speaker is allotted **three (3) minutes** to speak.

## Can I speak on behalf of an organization?

No. Five-minute representation requests are NOT permitted during Public Comment Time.

# How do I sign up to speak?

### **In-Person Sign-Ups**

- Sign-ups start **30 minutes before** the meeting.
- Sign-ups close 15 minutes after Public Comment Time begins.
- Sign-up sheets are available at the back of Board Chambers or in the McCoart atrium.
- You must provide your name, address, or Magisterial District.

## Remote Participation (Virtual Sign-Ups)

- Register by 5:00 PM the day before the meeting at <u>pwcgov.granicusideas.com</u>.
- IT staff will verify remote speakers when they join the meeting.
- Speakers are called in the order they registered.
- Verified participants may disconnect and rejoin while Public Comment Time is ongoing.
- In-person speakers speak before virtual speakers.
- Residents of Prince William County are called before non-residents.

# **Large Meeting Procedures FAQ**

# How is sign-in managed for large meetings?

- Sign-in is managed by the Clerk's Office and designated County staff.
- Individuals must sign in personally; no proxy sign-ins allowed.
- You must provide your name, address, or Magisterial District.
- Each speaker receives a numbered card upon sign-in (resident/non-resident distinction).

## What is the process for speaking at large meetings?

- **Time Limit:** Each speaker is allotted up to **3 minutes**.
- Speaker Line-Up:
  - Speakers line up in groups of 10.
  - o Staff will guide speakers to the microphone.
- Seating Availability:
  - 192 seats in the atrium.
  - o **112 seats** in Board Chambers.
- Calling Speakers:
  - The Chair will announce speakers in groups (e.g., "The next set of speakers are numbers 10 to 20.").
  - A designated staff member inside McCoart will assist in calling speaker numbers for those waiting in the atrium.
