Incidents

Attempted Carjacking – On July 15 at 3:11PM, officers responded to the area of Sudley Rd and Portsmouth Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate an attempted carjacking. The investigation revealed the victim, a 61-year-old woman, was stopped at the stop sign in the above area when an unknown man approached her vehicle. During the encounter, the man opened her passenger door and got into the vehicle where he then damaged the inside and attempted to remove the keys from the ignition. A physical altercation ensued before the suspect left on foot. The victim notified a nearby officer of the incident. No injuries were reported. A police K-9 and Fairfax police helicopter searched the area for the suspect who was not located.

Suspect Description:

Hispanic male, approximately 30 years of age, bald, 6'2" with a muscular build and tattoos Last seen wearing a white t-shirt and blue jeans

Arrests

Armed Robbery – On July 15 at 3:48PM, officers responded to the 5300 block of Dale Blvd in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, was walking with a female acquaintance in the above area when they were approached by two other juveniles, one of whom was known to the victim. During the encounter, a firearm was brandished, and the victim's backpack was taken. No injuries were reported. Responding officers located the two suspects at a business on Minnieville Rd where both were detained without incident and a firearm was recovered. Following the investigation, the two juvenile suspects, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile** and a **15-year-old male juvenile**, were arrested.
