Some notes up front:

You will first establish a **Household**, which is helpful if there are more than one person in your family who will be taking the training.

You will than add members to the household, those members are called **Volunteers**.

You will then pay for the course.

Virginia 4-H does not provide a **state code** and will not pay for the course. Unit 4-H offices may purchase a code if they want to. You can go to step 6 and it will ask you to pay by credit card.


Some counties will reimburse you for your credit card expense, other counties or clubs do not reimburse. The total cost is \$21.27.

3. If you do have a household set up already, simply enter your email and password, and click the 'LOGIN' button.






7. Once you are logged in, you need to set up profiles in your household that will take the course (if you don't already have any). To do this go to the "Household Members" tab:



8. On the household members tab click the "+ Household Member" button to create a profile for someone in the household that needs to take the training. Repeat this step for anyone that needs to take the course:




9. Once the profiles for the volunteer(s) are created, click the "Switch Profile" button on the top of the page to switch to the any of the volunteer profiles that have been created:




10. Once you are logged into any of the volunteer profiles you should see all of the same things on the dashboard that were on the primary account dashboard as well as one new "Redeem State Code" item


