**RE: RESOLUTION TO DECLARE, AFFIRM AND RECOGNIZE THE MONTHS
SEPTEMBER 15 TO OCTOBER 15, 2025, AS HISPANIC HERITAGE
MONTH**

ACTION:

WHEREAS, to honor the achievements of Hispanics, Congress has authorized and requested the President of the United States to issue a proclamation annually designating September 15 through October 15 as “National Hispanic Heritage Month.”

WHEREAS, this year’s theme, “*Collective Heritage: Honoring the Past, Inspiring the Future*”, is meant to capture the spirit of unity, resilience, and innovation.

WHEREAS, Hispanics account for approximately 25.2 percent of the Prince William County population and number more than 63.7 million or 19.5 percent of the population in the United States; making Hispanics the largest minority group in the country, and

WHEREAS, Hispanics contribute to the incredible diversity of the tenth most diverse county in the nation and the most diverse county in the Commonwealth of Virginia, with its rich history of different cultures and racial make-ups within the Hispanic community; and

WHEREAS, we, as a community and as a government, are proud of the cultural enrichment brought by our diverse Hispanic population and celebrate the many accomplishments of Hispanics throughout our Nation, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and Prince William County

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Prince William County Human Rights Commission declares, affirms, and recognizes the month of September 15 to October 15, 2025, as Hispanic Heritage Month and urges all citizens and residents to join and support all County celebrations honoring the rich heritage of our Hispanic workforce and residents during this period.

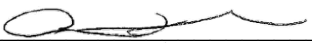
