Strong-Arm Robbery *WANTED SUSPECT – Prince William County police are currently seeking the suspect involved in the robbery that was reported to have occurred at the ABC Store located at 14220 Smoketown Rd. in Woodbridge (22192) on April 8. During the investigation, officers identified the suspect as Steven Eric **GILES** and obtained an arrest warrant. Attempts to locate the suspect have been unsuccessful.

Strong-Arm Robbery [Previously Released] – On April 8 at 6:55PM, officers responded to the ABC Store located at 14220 Smoketown Rd. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man went behind the service counter where he threatened the employee and then pushed her out of the way before taking multiple bottles of alcohol and leaving the store. No injuries were reported. Officers and a police K-9 searched the area for the suspect who was not located.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm – On September 17 at 9:50PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 3900 block of Triad Ct in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the homeowner reportedly heard gunshots earlier in the evening around 8:00PM before locating damage to the home later in the night. No injuries or other property damage were reported.

Vandalism on School Grounds – On September 17 at 1:27PM, the School Resource Officer assigned to Gainesville High School located at 13150 University Blvd in Gainesville (20155) was notified of vandalism in one of the boy's bathrooms. The investigation revealed derogatory language, and a swastika were etched into a bathroom stall wall. The etchings were recently observed and reported to school personnel. No additional markings were reported. School personnel removed the markings.
