What is the Miracle League of Prince William County?

- The Miracle League Program is a nationally recognized program with presently 350 plus Miracle League Organizations across the country including Puerto Rico, Mexico and Canada, while serving 250,000 plus children and adults. There are presently two other programs in the state of Virginia (City of Alexandria & Richmond) Miracle League web site: www.miracleleague.com.
- The program removes the barriers that keep children and adults with mental and physical disabilities off the baseball field and lets them experience the joy of America's favorite pastime.
- The Miracle League is about making new friends, building self-esteem and being treated just like other athletes.
- Provides children between the ages of 5 - 17 and adults 18 years & up, regardless of their ability to play Miracle League Baseball with the opportunity to hit a ball off a batting tee or pitched too depending upon ability, throw, catch a ball and score a run.
- Team members are assigned "Angels in the Outfield Buddies" who assist them in hitting, catching and throwing the ball and running the bases. Buddies can be fellow family members, schoolmates, parents, college students, little league teams, business leaders or anyone who wishes to volunteer their time to give a child or adult the gift of baseball. Volunteer Buddies must sign up ahead of time as each game will have a limited number.
- The field is a special rubberized 60' diamond shaped surface baseball field that accommodates wheelchairs and other assertive devices while helping to prevent injuries.
- Spring Season on Saturdays, April 11–May 16.
- Games will be played in Prince William County at Dr. Richard Tami Miracle Field located at the George Hellwig Park, 14420 Bristow Road, Manassas, Virginia 20112.

The Mission of Our Program

- Promote community support, partnerships, and sponsorships of Miracle League of Prince William County for youth and adult adaptive sports.
- To eliminate the main barriers for these youth and adults that arise from playing on natural grass fields used in conventional leagues by playing the Miracle League program will play on a custom-designed, rubberized surface field.
- Provide resources and networking opportunities for our special families.

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Who Can Sign Up/How to Register?

- Children who participate in either Recreation Department programs, Prince William County School System, City of Manassas Park School System or within any agency/organization in the County/City. Non-residents are eligible to participate.
- We are currently seeking participants (youth ages 5 to adults) for the Spring 2026.
- Participation is open for any person with mental and/or physical challenges who reside within or outside of Prince William County.
- Fee: \$50/player.

Game Format For the Season

- 1 hour. No scores or standings are recorded.
- There will be two games hosted. Game A time will be scheduled from 8:45 – 9:45am. Game B time will be scheduled from 10 – 11am. Your time slot will be determined based upon registration. Players will be notified of their game slot in advance of the first game date.
- Inclement weather days will be played at Lake Ridge Middle School or Benton Middle School.
- Fall and Spring seasons will generally run for 6 weeks.
- Games will be 2 innings depending upon time, number of participants and weather.
- Each player will have the opportunity to play in the field and bat off a batting tee each inning - every hit is a homerun and scores.
- Gloves, bats, soft baseballs/softballs, batting tees, helmets and water will be provided each game day.
- Games will have an announcer and coaches for the bases.
- Between innings players and buddies will be able to enjoy singing "Take Me Out To The Ball Game" and will have dance music on the field following the game.
