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Program Policy

Prince William Public Libraries' (PWPL) programs align with its Strategic Plan, are equitable, and are not chosen based on personal beliefs, or political views. Programs may be presented by staff, volunteers, partner organizations, or paid presenters. Library programs are curated to connect our community with diverse, inclusive, and educational ideas and perspectives to include, but not limited to, early literacy, family programs, community building, entertainment, and programs for all ages.

All PWPL programs are open to the public. Registration may be required for planning purposes or when space is limited. Programs may be held on-site, off-site, or virtually.

External organizations or individuals partnering with PWPL on programs must coordinate marketing efforts and secure PWPL staff approval before distributing promotional materials.

PWPL reserves the right to edit any copy provided by a program presenter.

The PWPL Director must approve any sales of products at library programs.
